ORDINANCE No. 188974

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Structural Rehabilitation of Taggart Outfall 30 Project No. E10220 for an estimated cost of \$8 million (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to structurally rehabilitate the Taggart Outfall 30. The 10-foot diameter brick outfall in inner southeast Portland was built in 1906 to convey combined sewer flows away from the city's largest basin area, Taggart A, B, C, and D. The outfall was found to have some deterioration while conducting the Large Diameter Inspection Program. This project will construct 3400 linear feet of structural liner system internal to the existing brick sewer to extend the useful life of the outfall an additional 100 years.
- 2. BES, along with Jacobs Engineering, has prepared plans and specifications for the Structural Rehabilitation of the Taggart Outfall Project. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of material and labor for this project.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$8 million. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2018-2019, CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$8 million.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- c. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
