ORDINANCE No. 189021

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation and accept a grant in the amount of \$2,000,000. for the design, right-of-way and construction of the Seventies Neighborhood Greenway project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. PBOT has received a total of \$2,000,000.00 in federal funds to design and construct the Seventies Neighborhood Greenway.
- 2. There are significant gaps in the City's bikeway network that discourage riding bikes to work, school, shopping, etc. The Seventies Greenway project will address deficiencies in this corridor.
- 3. The project will address these deficiencies by filling in major gaps between safe and comfortable north-south pedestrian and bicycle routes in the City.
- 4. Specifically, the route will provide 11 enhanced crossing treatments such as curb extensions, island, RRFBs, cycle tracks, multiuse paths, etc. for pedestrian and bicyclists at busy streets and nearby schools.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low. The project plans and construction estimate have not been developed yet. PBOT is expecting to start design as soon as this ordinance is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute this IGA and to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Seventieth Greenway Neighborhood project in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.
