

ORDINANCE No. 189024

* Pay property damage and bodily injury claims of Tesfaye Worku in the sum of \$22,806 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Water Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Tesfaye Worku, through attorney Yunus Muhammad Paisner, has filed a property damage and bodily injury claims against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Water Bureau on May 24, 2017.
2. The claims have been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$22,806 with \$21,806 still due, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$15,965 payable to Yunus M. Paisner, Attorney PC and Tesfaye Worku, and a second check payable to Hudson Insurance Company in the amount of \$5,841.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute payment authorizations in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling these claims; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
