ORDINANCE No. 189060

* Pay settlement of employment practices lawsuit of Kathleen Preston in the sum of \$25,000 involving the Portland Parks Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Kathleen Preston, through attorney Benjamin Rosenthal, has filed a lawsuit against the City for damages related to her employment with Portland Parks and Recreation that ended on December 15, 2016.
- 2. Risk Management Services investigated the allegations in the suit. The investigation indicates there is risk to the City. Therefore, to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award and the expense of ongoing litigation, it is prudent to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$25,000 subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks in the total amount of \$25,000 as follows:
 - 1) a payroll check paid to Kathleen Preston in the amount of \$6,240 less the usual and standard withholding taxes and deductions;
 - a check jointly payable to Kathleen Preston and Benjamin Rosenthal, Attorney at Law in the amount of \$18,760 representing non-economic damages and attorney's fees and costs.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amounts set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this employment lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
