ORDINANCE No. 189151

Designate a prefix abbreviation for South Portland addresses effective May 1, 2020 (Ordinance; replace Code Section 17.92.020)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Council approved Ordinance No. 188995 on June 6, 2018 establishing a sixth addressing sextant in the City of Portland and in Multnomah County. This area east of SW Naito Parkway, SW View Point Terrace and Tryon Creek State Natural Area will change from Southwest Portland addressing to South Portland addressing effective May 1, 2020.
- 2. The Maintenance Operations section of the Portland Bureau of Transportation confirmed on June 15, 2018 its intent to fabricate new South Portland street signs beginning on March 15, 2020 and concluding by April 30, 2020 to have street name signage ready by the May 1, 2020 implementation date of South Portland addressing.
- Street signs with the current addressing prefixes of East, North, Northeast, Southeast, Southwest and West are abbreviated as "E", "N", "NE", "SE" and "SW", respectively, to avoid excessively long street name signs in accordance with standards established in Section 2E.17 of the 2009 Edition of Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.
- 4. Current Code Section 17.92.020 does not include a designated abbreviation of "S" for the South Portland street name prefix, which is required in advance of fabrication of new street signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That Code Section 17.92.020 is replaced in its entirety with Exhibit A of this Ordinance.
- b. That this Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after Council passage.
