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the system. And I feel that the No. 1 objective for Black Americans is to recognize that they have the same equal rights under the Constitution as Ford or Rockefeller, even if we have no blue-chip stocks. But our membership in the United States is the supreme blue-chip stock, and the one we have to exercise.

"I believe that this will call for a tremendous shift of energy—that black people need to focus their energies on improving the system, as opposed to banging on the door to get in, or to tearing it down because they are not let in.

"We are living in a very dangerous international situation. The whole concept of democratic institutions is under attack, by very powerful forces that have every intention of eliminating democratic procedures, because these procedures pose a constant threat to their own authoritarian regimes. Now the Sakharovs and the Solzhenitsyns are trying to communicate to the Western world a very complicated reality: that inside the socialist countries there are people who have lived and suffered under their dictatorial re-

gimes, and who want democratic institutions and procedures. It's a very dangerous problem because, in order to keep the lid on it, the rulers of these countries have to have a foreign devil, and that is us.

"They are able to maintain their mobilization and very stringent control by focusing on the need to confront the United States of America. We have to be very careful in safeguarding our institutions and our liberties, and in carrying on our arguments and our disagreements in a more sophisticated manner. What it adds up to is a new approach to change; we must not fall back into the old status quo.

"But we cannot afford the luxury of the kind of wild housecleaning that we have attempted in the past; that just rocks the boat until the boat starts to go under. There are other people who are waiting for that moment of instability when they can help *hold* the boat under.

"Together, we must build on the good in America, positively and carefully, and change the bad—to save our souls, and all humanity."

THE EDUCATION OF ELDRIDGE CLEAVER

FEW NEWS STORIES in recent years have caused more confusion and consternation than the announcement by Eldridge Cleaver, former Black Panther leader and fugitive from justice, that he was returning to the United States and to prison. Reports after his arrival and arrest indicated that Cleaver's radicalism had undergone a radical change, that the bitterness and hatred which had characterized his rhetoric had been replaced by a new voice of moderation, even of reconciliation.

What is the truth? Did Cleaver's odyssey through Communist and Third World nations profoundly alter his political views? Has he experienced, as some reports have stated, a true "conversion"? Perhaps only time will answer such questions. But the mystery that surrounded Cleaver's seven-year exile and his dramatic return to the United States is here dispelled via an extraordinary series of interviews obtained with Cleaver—in jail.

"I'D RATHER BE IN JAIL in America than free anywhere else." Bicentennial slogan? Campaign oratory? No. Words from Eldridge Cleaver, the fiery Black Panther revolutionary, who *is* in jail. Cleaver should know what he's talking about. He has been in and out of detention centers since he was 12 years old. He has spent nine years in California prisons: San Quentin, Folsom, Soledad.

What do we make of a man

labeled as a dangerous rebel who voluntarily gives up life in Paris with his family, a Mediterranean apartment for his writing, the security of government protection, for an American prison cell? Returning was his own idea, despite the fact that he knew he would be arrested the moment he landed.* Now he awaits trial, in Oakland's Alameda County jail, on "parole hold" (no bail allowed), facing charges for which the top sentence is life imprisonment.

As he fights for his freedom, he is

also fighting for credibility. To rightists, who remember his "Off the pig!" "Down the Pentagon!" sentiments of 1968, he'll always be suspect. But now his old party, the Black Panthers, has denounced him as an informer. Only one thing seems sure: Cleaver no longer fits the familiar boxes, right or left. He insists: "I'm my own man." Today he declares: "The politics of the 1960s are exhausted, at all levels. We must work within the framework of our institutions."

To get a handle on the Cleaver mystery, one must understand three things: why he fled the United States, why he returned and, of greatest importance, what happened to him in between. Here is his story-book adventure.

"We Were Afraid." In November 1968, parolee Eldridge Cleaver slipped across the Canadian border to catch a ship that would take him to Cuba and "freedom." Why did he leave? He feared for his life. If he had to go back to San Quentin to await trial on the police-assault charge, he "knew" there would never be a trial. He'd be killed first, conditions being what they were. "We were all afraid," he says. "The police were afraid. People were being killed."

When Cleaver dropped out of sight, he was Black Panther minister of information, a potent force in an exploding people's movement. Under his leadership, the Black Panthers had developed from a local Oakland organization into an inter-

national movement being copied by liberationists around the world. As a writer—his *Soul on Ice* was a best-seller—Cleaver was both symbol and spokesman for a public that transcended race and class. His enemies had good reason to want him out of the way.

Cleaver's fears were well-founded. Two more Panthers were killed on January 17, 1969. "I remember the date because my best friend was killed—Bunchy Carter," Cleaver recalls. "And throughout the year there was nothing but attacks by police against various offices of the Black Panther Party. It ended in December with the death of Fred Hampton [Illinois chairman of the Black Panthers] in Chicago."

Last April, the U.S. Senate's Select Committee on Intelligence Activities reported that in August 1967 the FBI had "initiated a covert action program to disrupt and neutralize organizations which it characterized as 'black nationalist hate groups.'" As the *New York Times* put it: "The FBI carried out a secret, nationwide effort to destroy the Black Panthers, including attempts to stir up bloody gang warfare between the Panthers and other groups, and to create factional splits within the party."

Identity Crisis. Years ago, Cleaver wrote that prison plays havoc with one's identity. Today, he says that exile is much the same. "I came to understand that exile is a sort of inverted example of being in prison. When you are in jail inside your

me to my point of view. It was my own *experiences*, leading me to refresh my contact with the whole spiritual dimension. What I found was that my previous philosophy had an emptiness at the core.

"I came to see that there is a fundamental mistake contained in the Marxist-Leninist ideologies, where they make the distinction between idealism and materialism. Everything dealing with the spirit or with religious subjects is lumped under 'idealism' and condemned as being 'the opium of the people.' I came to feel that there is not only room but a necessity for us to address ourselves to morality and the relationship between people. What made Marxism-Leninism unworkable was that there was no humanity in it, no love."

"So I was wrong, and the Black Panthers were wrong. We had a totally political and economic approach, without giving any consideration to the more civilizing influences. Materialism, racial separation, destructive negativism, hate—they won't do the job. I can see that, now." Cleaver had reached the point where he wanted to return to America even if he had to straighten out his life from jail.

Prodigal's Return? On November 18, 1975, the FBI arrested Cleaver as he stepped off the plane in New York. Why had he returned? He had changed. His country had changed. "After the end of the war in Indochina and the destruction of the Nixon regime, and the change

of the political situation of blacks—like white people voting for black mayors—all this indicated to me that the political situation in the United States is not what it was in 1968. It calls for a reassessment."

Today, fresh currents swirl around Cleaver: new revelations, new rumors, new attacks. Few things have so disturbed him as the claim of a jail-visiting Fundamentalist preacher of Eldridge's sudden "conversion in his cell." Cleaver says, "I've studied carefully, and I agree with the teaching of Jesus, but I don't like the idea that I've been 'born again in my cell.' I'm certain that people would see that as some kind of opportunistic gambit on my part. Also, there's nothing 'sudden' about it; it has been a very painful change that has taken place over a considerable period of time."

As for his turbulent past, Cleaver has no regrets. The Black Panthers? "That's not where I am now, but it's where I learned." *Soul on Ice*? "Those are not my words now, but they were honest at the time."

Cleaver claims to have a unique perspective on our country. "I know the plans of other nations for the United States. Given the intentions of other powers, we can't afford race hatred or class war.

"In the past, the question was raised as to whether or not blacks were going to be a part of America; whether we were going to be let into the political process. Now I think that question has been resolved, and we are here to stay. We are inside

gatherings where the plans of other nations for the United States were freely discussed. "What was being said was really the projection of an entire strategy—namely that, first, the international communist movement would 'liberate' the so-called Third World, and would colonize the world. That would isolate the United States. At the same time, the superiority in the balance of armed power would be shifting in favor of the new world. And then the moment would come when, because of the internal disintegration of the United States, it would be possible to destroy the U.S. military machine." Then the revolutionaries within the United States would seize power.

"The revolutionaries abroad have a slogan: 'We will destroy them from without; they will destroy them from within.' In Africa, you find the Soviets and Cubans, when they are planning their strategy for Angola or Rhodesia, taking for granted that they can count on certain things happening inside the United States that will coincide with their strategy. They take for granted that they can count on certain elements inside the United States. This is part of their perspective: that they are eventually going to conquer and destroy; that they will win."

These revelations, Cleaver says, he heard sometimes in official speeches, sometimes over cocktails at embassies. "I've talked with generals from the Soviet Union and marshals from China. I've been present when they toasted the destruction of the United

States. They carry on constant planning of surprise attacks. They are out to eliminate, if possible, but in any case, to surround and surpass and neutralize the United States."

Cleaver might be a revolutionary, but it began to hit home: the democratic process and idealism were things to take seriously.

Sentenced to Think. Paris was the final and "quiet phase" of Cleaver's exile. For the first year he remained under cover. Eventually, however, moves were made by the French government to legalize the Cleavers' stay. The requirement: that they engage in no political activity of any kind.

It was as if the price of asylum were a sentence to think. Cleaver turned to liberators who had made a mark. He looked again at Malcolm X and Martin Luther King, Jr., going back over King's speeches and writings, and following up the references that had influenced him: Emerson, Thoreau, Walter Rauschenbusch, the social-gospel preacher/teacher of pre-World War I.

"When King mentioned that Rauschenbusch's *Social Principles of Jesus* had influenced him, I immediately got hold of a copy, and found there an approach to Jesus most in harmony with my own concerns. It deals with the Jesus who was concerned about the social situation, and was really like the voice of the greatest revolutionary. So I studied this, and I studied the Bible.

"But it wasn't *reading* that took

country, there is a certain cramped experience; but when you are outside, you feel the same way, except it's not cramped—it's an expanding kind of confinement."

Lying low, he often assumed an alias. "I went through a real identity crisis by using so many false names. Once, at a border, I couldn't remember who I was supposed to be. I wasn't drunk or sleepy; it was just something psychological."

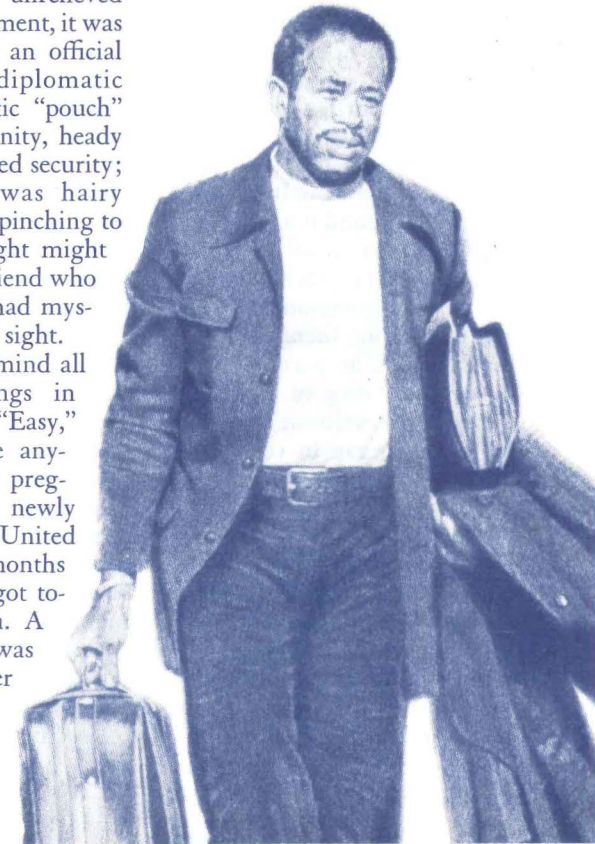
But beyond the confused suspension that haunts the impostor was an electric context that enveloped the whole enterprise: the unrelieved sense of danger. One moment, it was luxurious hospitality as an official guest enjoying quasi-diplomatic status, with a diplomatic "pouch" and privileges of immunity, heady invitations and guaranteed security; another moment, it was hairy escapes, scrounging and pinching to survive. Any day or night might bring word of another friend who had been murdered or had mysteriously dropped out of sight.

How can he keep in mind all the comings and goings in those seven hectic years? "Easy," he laughs. "I can date anything from my wife's pregnancies. Kathleen was newly pregnant when I left the United States. She was eight months along when we finally got together again in Algeria. A month later, our son was born there. Our daughter was born in North Korea. They're seven and

six now. There were times when it was rough, and we had to place the children with other people—once for a year. One of my longings is to have a normal, peaceful family life. It becomes a dream to people in my situation."

Cuba Libre? During these years, Cleaver's exile moved through three stages: disillusionment in Cuba; travel and testing from an Algerian base; study and ripening in Paris.

Cleaver went to Cuba as an ally of the revolution, at the invitation of Castro. He looked to Cuba as



a model of liberation. It turned out to be a model of oppression. The real mood there is one of hopelessness and anguish; one also of constant complaint. "It comes as a shock to you, when you think that everyone is happy under Castro's socialism, to find out how resentful they are of the economic shortages and of the contrast in the obvious privileges that party members have as opposed to regular people.

"There are special brigades of people who run around catching the dissenters. My security man had three machine guns that he used to leave at my house. At any time of the day or night, he might run in, grab one, and run out again.

"The main point is that the people have no machinery by which to bring their will to bear upon the decision-making process. It was a sad discovery, but I found it to be so, not just in Cuba, but in all the countries we traveled in which have similar dictatorial governments. The leaders are out for themselves, not for the people. The party will destroy you at the drop of a hat."

Cleaver's own welcome wore out when he, too, began to voice criticisms. When a Reuters newsman found out who he was and told the world that Cleaver was in Havana, he became too hot to handle. "They planned to get me to Algeria, to take off the spotlight that my presence had brought. I had Castro's personal word that I could return to Cuba, but soon learned that he had no intention of ever letting me back."

"**White American.**" Algeria was to be the Cleavers' base for four years. Eldridge found it to be "a sort of wide-open, shoot-from-the-hip Wild West place. The government rides herd heavily on its own people; but, as far as the foreign community is concerned, it's quite a different world, freer, physically apart." Kathleen brushed up her French and became the interpreter for the international section of the Black Panther Party that they organized in Algiers.

Here, in this center of the Third World network, living in a government-grant villa, they received messages and visitors. Cleaver visited most of the new African nations and zigzagged across four continents as ambassador of a liberation movement. He was an official guest at the huge Pan African Cultural Festival and a delegate at the International Congress of Communist Journalists.

One thing he learned early: "I am not an African. The fundamental thing, I guess, is culture. I mean, culturally and linguistically I am an American, but in my particular case there are also blood differences. The Black American people here have been so admixed with other races that when you go to Africa and meet people from pure stock, you recognize that you are different. They call you 'white'! It was very traumatic for me to be treated as a *white* American."

In Algeria was assembled the delegation with whom he took a trip to Asia, in 1971, enjoying red-carpet

treatment as "the U.S. People's Anti-Imperialist Delegation" in North Korea, North Vietnam, China. From these countries, he learned also about not throwing the baby out with the bath water: "They didn't just totally reject their historical and traditional foundations. They pointed out how destructive it was when you did this and when you tried to substitute a brand-new philosophy. So, seeing how they did it, I realized how amateurish and silly we were being."

At this time, too, Cleaver experienced the great gravitational-force field between Russia and China. "The Russians and Chinese were always vying with each other for the allegiance of everybody else. If you showed partiality toward the Chinese, then the Russians hated you—and vice versa. It was an open scandal that the Chinese and Russians were being very cynical toward the Vietnamese people's struggle. They liked to run in their newspapers how much they were helping liberation movements; but when you actually talked with these people, you found they drive really hard bargains. They don't even trust themselves.

"An example: we were guests of the Koreans in Moscow, and when we sat down to eat, the Russians said, 'No rubles, no soup!' They wanted us to pay in advance. They said to us, 'This isn't aimed at you, but we know that Koreans sometimes don't pay their bills, so if you want to eat, pay first!'

"There is no room for this stuff about 'international brotherhood

and solidarity.' After the bill is paid, you can chant those phrases; but until it's paid, it's like a confrontation."

"**Kill Americans.**" At the same time, Cleaver discovered the booby traps of revolutionary language. "When an American talks about changing or smashing the government, he doesn't mean the same thing that a foreigner means. When I said, 'Down the Pentagon!' I meant get rid of the present general staff, or something like that. By 'Clean out Congress,' I meant: 'Let's get rid of some of those Senators.' But foreigners mean: 'Obliterate it.'

"Here's an example: a guy from a country on the Arabian peninsula stood up in an embassy meeting that I attended and said, 'I think we should adopt a strategy of killing Americans on sight.' Was he serious? Absolutely. He thought this would paralyze the operations of the American government internationally and 'strike terror to the heart of the imperialist beast.' He delivered this with passion, and people clapped because they thought it was great. That's how a lot of people feel about America. I rose to a point of order and let him know that he had to make distinctions among Americans; not all Americans are bad.

"After I started arguing the point, he said, 'Okay, we won't kill the black ones.' 'Well,' I said, 'you have some bad black people and some good black people. So that kind of strategy is not one we can support.'"

Cleaver's most astonishing experience abroad was to be invited to

NARRATIVE

Sir: With the assistance of Detective Donald J. Schmitt, I interviewed NATHANIEL FENNEL at the Oregon State Correctional Institute relative to the Black Panthers and their possible involvement in the Grandma Cookie burning and other acts of violence. Mr. FENNEL was very cooperative and talked freely of his activities and the crimes which he has allegedly committed. Mr. FENNEL has only been at OSCI for only four days and is serving a 10 year sentence for 2nd degree arson. FENNEL insists that he was not involved in the Grandma Cookie arson and that it was by coincidence that he was in the area at the time of the fire. We discussed the circumstances surrounding his trial and other aspects of the crime for some time.

Mr. FENNEL appeared to be at ease during the conversation and readily answered all of our questions. As far as the Black Panthers are concerned, FENNEL indicates that CLAUDE HAWKINS is the only Panther ^{he is} ~~is~~ acquainted with. He indicated that he met HAWKINS while in Rocky Butte Jail, but they have never discussed any of the Panthers programs, nor any acts of violence involving the Panthers. In general, FENNEL seemed to know very little about the Panthers, and could be of no assistance in our investigation. After some two hours the interview was terminated.

NARRATIVE

Sir: Mr. Cameron was contacted at the Kaiser Foundation Health Research Institute concerning the free medical care given to needy families in the Albina area. I learned from Mr. Cameron that 1.7 Million Dollars has been granted for free health care to low income families in the Portland area. The plan is paid to Kaiser through Dept. of Health, Education & Welfare. This fund was formerly administered by the Office of Economic Opportunity but was transferred to HEW last year. Currently there are ~~XXXX~~ 1,500 plus families being served in Portland. To qualify for this program low income families must reside in designated depressed areas. At the present time the areas being served are as follows.

750 families in Albina
 200 families in North Portland
 50 families in West Portland
 380 families in the Brooklyn-Richmond-Buckman & Sunnyside areas
 50 families in other areas scattered throughout the city.

Mr. Cameron explained that the latter figure represents families who applied for the services while in the above designated areas but subsequently moved out of these areas and are still receiving the benefits.

There is no cost to the families for the following services.

- Prescription drugs
- Glasses
- Doctors' services
- Hospital services
- Mental Health
- Dental Services
- Transportation

Funds are available to serve a maximum of 1,500 families, however, at the present time they are running slightly over that figure. There have been no openings in the program since July of 1970 and Mr. Cameron does not expect they will accept new applicants for another 3 or 4 months.

Those who qualify for the program are further screened by the following priorities.

- #1 - Large families
- #2 - Families with serious medical problems

- #3 - Single parent families ~~or young couples~~
- #4 - Young couples
- #5 - Large families with head of household between ages of 45 and 62 yrs.

Applications are accepted over the telephone and a list is made of those families requesting the services of this program. When an opening occurs those on the list are further interviewed by a representative of this program and the families are selected according to the above priorities.

Sir: Contacted a confidential informant 4:30 p.m., 9-22-70, and learned that he was present when KENT FORD and a number of Black Panthers were discussing the arrest of KENT FORD by Special Officer Ed Hall. FORD referred to HALL as "about licking pig that had to be done away with." Informant stated that he has been a life-long friend of ED HALL and does not want to see him hurt.

He voiced his objection to FORD by saying that he didn't mind if he was roughed up a bit, but did not want to see him killed. FORD stated that the question had been settled and that HALL had to be "done away with." The informant added that those in attendance were young kids and FORD seemed to be the spokesman for the group. The others broke into smaller discussion groups, but when FORD spoke everyone listened. He appeared to be inciting them into taking some sort of action. The informant stated that he didn't think FORD would do anything himself, nor would he direct any one person to hurt HALL but that he would by his speaking attempt to incite others into taking some independent action.

The informant will attempt to obtain further information from the Panthers which he will forward to us.

I contacted the manager of Killingsworth Albertson's Store, Mr. LAKEY, relative to the three thefts he experienced by black men on 9/20/70. (see reports 70-71427 and 70-71228). About two months ago Mr. LAKEY was approached by the Black Panthers and asked to donate turkeys and ham to the breakfast program. At that time he told them that he would have to check with his general office before he could make any donations. They told him that they had already checked at the head office. Mr. LAKEY again told them that he would not donate until he received an okay from them and he would also check about the legitimacy of the program. He had received several phone calls after that; however, none were of a threatening nature. About a month ago he did donate some turkeys and hams to one of the neighborhood churches for a revival hour service which was held at Unthank Park. There is ~~km~~ no known connection with this program and the Black Panthers.

He states that he was again contacted by the Black Panthers about two weeks ago and asked to donate turkeys and hams and he gave them the same answer. Again he states there was no threat made.

By coincidence, he has experienced three small fires in their refuse drop box which is located near the back of the building. There has been no damage to the store as a result of the fires. On the morning of 9/21/70 Mr. LAKEY discovered that a fire smoldering in the drop box and noticed that it had burned itself out and was just smoldering ~~and~~ in the sawdust at the bottom of the box. There are no suspects in this arson. (case no 70-71258).

NARRATIVE

Sir: At approximately 10 AM, 9/21/70, the writer contacted the Albertsons manager, Mr. Ronald LAKEY, relative to the hams being stolen of the night before. Mr. LAKEY indicated that there were three separate incidents of theft of hams within one hour. The first two were reported to police on 9/21/70 and the third had not been reported and it is not known whether they are connected. The first occasion as reported in case 70-71228 involved three subjects in a 1964 blue Thunderbird, Ore 5Y-702. In this case two men entered the store, loaded up two shopping carts full of picnic hams and walked out without paying. When they were confronted by store employees, the employees were beaten up and the suspects threw the hams on the ground and left in a 1964 Blue Thunderbird, Ore 5Y-702. Forty-three picnic hams were recovered with a total value of \$224.80.

Mr. LAKEY, the store manager, was called to the store from his home. When he arrived, Mr RHOADES explained what had happened and took him outside to show him where the hams had been recovered. When they started back in the store, they observed the two suspects of this case come out of the store, each carrying shopping bags containing three hams each. Mr. LAKEY confronted them and asked for receipts and was told by one of the two "My wife paid for them". Mr. LAKEY had observed that they had not passed through the checkout counter and asked for the hams back; however, the subjects refused. Mr. LAKEY then obtained a gun from the office and forced the suspects to surrender the hams. They then walked to a car parked on the parking lot and drove away. The car was described as a '69 Oldsmobile, blue in color, with a black vinyl top. As they left, one of them stated "I'm going to get your white mother-fucking ass". Mr. LAKEY indicated that he did not obtain the license number. Mr. LAKEY states that he thinks he would be able to identify these

subjects. States that he would like to view mugs after he gets off of work at 6 PM. An appointment was made at that time for Mr. LAKEY and Mr. Robert RHOADES to view mugs. After looking at the mugs and Militant file and the general file in the ID Division, they were not able to make an identification; however, selected PPD# 37555, JEFFERSON NMI DAVIS as a likeness of one of the subjects.

The third incident, Mr. LAKEY spoke of was a negro male shoplifter who picked up one ham from the meat section and walked out of the door. One of the employees in the meat section saw the subject but was unable to identify or give an accurate description.

HE indicated that at the time the subj spoke with him he was wanted by the police on a Misdemeanor Warrant and had risked apprehension to inform HALL OF A threat that he had overheard.

There is to be a meeting of Kent Ford and associates the next few days to discuss this bombing and decide on who is to do the job.

Agent Snyder stated that when he comes into possession on details of the meeting, or it's content, he will relay this information to this detail.

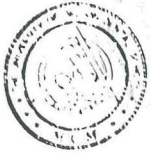

Panthers Fail To Seek Permit To Solicit Funds

19

No action was taken on one item on the Public Solicitations Commission agenda Wednesday.

The Black Panthers did not show up.

After receiving several inquiries from the public on whether the Panthers had been granted a permit to solicit funds, the city's Bureau of Revenue and Treasury decided to take the mountain to Mohammed.

A field man took a form, which must be filled out giving the philanthropic use for the money, the financial goal, the expense of the campaign and officials in charge, to a North Vancouver Avenue address, supposedly the Panthers' headquarters.

The form also asks if the applicant is a member of UGN and where he banks.

'Hand' Takes Form

The form was received from the field man "by a hand." Not enough of a body showed to tell whether it was male or female.

When it appeared the Panthers had mislaid the form, a certified letter was sent explaining that if the Solicitation

Ordinance was violated there would be a \$500 fine or six-month jail sentence.

The letter was unclaimed. The diligent city bureau discovered a new address for the Panther headquarters and issued an invitation to appear at the Wednesday meeting.

No Panther representative accepted the invitation.

In other business, the commission recommended to the City Council that the application of St. Paul Church Mission, dated Sept. 8, 1970, be denied.

The Mission wanted to sell candy and solicit cash to build a home for retarded children. The Rev. Jonah Taylor, 3406 NE 14th Ave., president and manager of the Mission, does have a permit to solicit clothing and furniture for sale at a second hand store. Proceeds are to go to building the home.

Accounting Lacking

It was pointed out that despite requests, the Rev. Mr. Taylor had failed to provide adequate accounting of funds and had demonstrated a "lack of cooperation with established authorities," according to Commissioner John Crowell.

The commission approved recommendations of:

Tri County Chapter, the National Foundation-March of Dimes to raise \$118,000 at a cost of \$20,000; the City of Hope-Save a Life League No. 369, \$3,000 with \$100 expense; Westside School for Exceptional Children, \$3,500, no expense; Waverly Children's Home, \$550,000, with \$30,000-35,000 expense; Good Samaritan Church of God in Christ, \$100, no expense; Villa St. Rose School Auxiliary, \$600, merchandise expense; United Fellowship Christian Alliance Inc., \$150,000, \$30,000 expense; Church of The Living God, \$7,000, at \$200 expense; Wilson High School Choir, \$8,000, no expense.


As of this date, we have not received a completed application for permit although we understand that your solicitation for funds is continuing.

He stated that FIKES might possibly be from Washington and his name had been appearing more and more frequently as being a part of the Black Panther constituency and a confident of KENT FORD, and also involved in the Black Panther Breakfast Program.

He said the informant, who had been very reliable in the past, said that the new Lou Williams Cadillac agency, across the street from Benson High School, had been solicited for funds for the Breakfast Program, and had refused. The informant stated that within two weeks or earlier, possibly within one week, this agency would be dynamited by JEFF FIKES if no funds were forthcoming for the Program. MANNIX stated he would attempt to gain more certain information and to the date and time of the proposed bombing, (with dynamite) and relay it to the writer.

The officers stated that they had been contacted by special officer Brown, who is employee security at this store and was informed by him that Kent Ford and Jeffery Fykes, PPD #56786, had been driving around and around the store in a two tone green, '60 Buick, Ore. BBW 011. This is reported to be Fykes automobile. The uniformed officers stated that from their observation Ford and Fykes did nothing except drive around the store several times. At one time they parked, Fykes got out of the car, went into the store, got a brown paper sack from one of the cash registers and left. No purchase was made by Fykes at this time. By the time we met with the uniformed officers, Ford and Fykes had left the area.

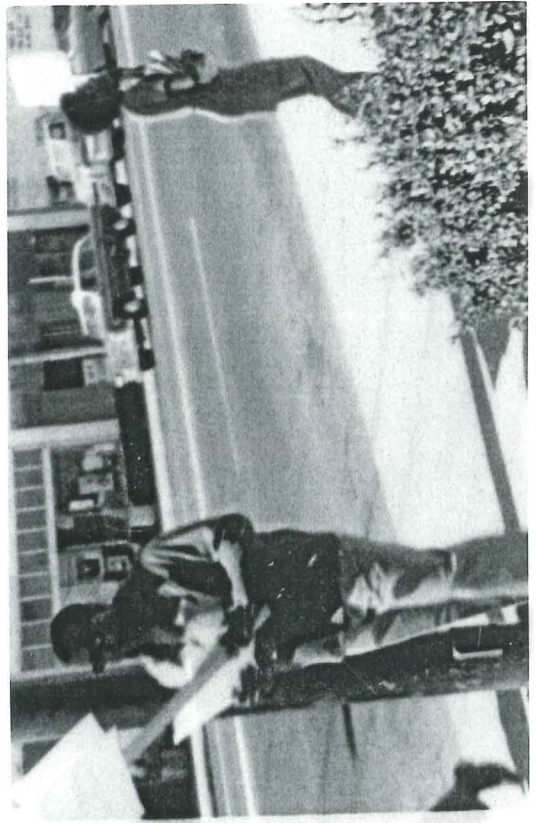

RE BLACK PANTHER BREAKFAST PROGRAM

NARRATIVE

Sir: In examining the case file on the Black Panther Breakfast Program, solicitation, it appears that a pattern is presently emerging as follows:

A group of black subjects approach a particular business with a female being the spokesman for the group. This group numbers four to six persons. While the female is engaged in conversation with the management of the business, the males mill around in a generally disruptive manner. If the demand for funds for the Program are not met, or if the persons soliciting are put off or asked to come back at a later date, they attempt to set a firm time as a deadline for contributions. No direct threats are ever made, and as few names as possible are mentioned with no introductions apparent other than the female solicitor, who usually identifies herself as one LINDA THORNTON.

Later that day, or the next day, an anonymous threatening phone call is then received with words used during the threat being generally the same to the effect, "You tell the man, or the manager, you're going to get bombed." With this in mind, possible methods of evidence collection were pursued and the feasibility of a telephone trap and tape recording of the telephone conversation were pursued. Some of the attendant problems with this approach are:

- (1) The legality of recorded telecommunications;
- (2) The problems of identifying the trace as to origination through the telephone company in a rapid manner;
- (3) The entrance of premises, (if premises are involved) for purposes of identifying the caller or people present, and testing to the line.

These problems were discussed with DDA Connall, who after researching the question of the telecommunication interception, agreed that if the subscribing party had knowledge of the recording, it was admissible in court and not illegal under federal and state statutes.

In regard to the second problem, in the past it has been necessary to dispatch two cars on the telephone trap, one to the party called and one to the end of the line from which the call originated. The car going to

the originator of the call must request entrance, and if gained, then check the line to make sure that it is to the party called. This is because the telephone company is unable to testify in court that the trace is infallible. If the officer is refused entrance to the originating line, the trap fails. Mr Connall stated under the hot pursuit theory, as well as recent case law, a probable cause search of premises would be in order and that the officer checking this end of the line could make entry as if by search warrant for the purpose of checking the telephone, obtaining fingerprints off the instrument and ascertain the person or persons present.

Early next week, the writer will take steps to install a telephone trap or traps in those business which seem most likely to be offended by the threatening call.

Mr Connall requested that due to the delicate nature of entrance into the originating premises of the phone call that detectives be dispatched in concert with uniformed officers immediately to the scene, and although this will involve some difficulty in liason through radio and the precincts, an attempt will be made to arrange for this coverage.

Contacted the manager of Frito Lay, ALLEN HAWTHORNE, and the manager of MR A.L. TODD, who informs me that on two occasions members of the Black Panthers came in requesting donations, however, received none. A phone call was received about three weeks later, threatening to blow the business up. Contacted City of Portland Licensing Bureau and was informed the Black Panthers have applied for a license to solicit funds for their breakfast program, however, have never completed the application. Also informed that it is ;contrary to city ordinance to solicit for any contributions without a license from the city.

NARRATIVE

Sir: Contacted the witness in this case, SANDRA GASKINS, who works for Frito Lay as a secretary/receptionist. MISS GASKINS informed me that on 8/19/70 a Negro female, described as early twenties, 5'1", to 5'3", medium complexion, red hair, Afro style, 115 lbs., wearing a maroon skirt and vest suit, and a Negro male, early twenties, 5'10", 160 lbs., came into the Frito Lay requesting to see the manager. When told the manager was out, they left a Black Panther pamphlet with information on the children's breakfast program. They were advised by GASKINS to return the next day.

On 8/20/70, three Negro females and three Negro males came to the Frito Lay again requesting to see the manager. They talked to the Assistant Manager, MR ALLEN W HAWTHORNE, 10710 NE Eugene, ph. 254-4639.

MR HAWTHORNE advised that these people requested a donation for the Black Panther breakfast program and wanted to know if the manager had seen the literature that they had left the previous day. MR HAWTHORNE told them that the manager had seen the literature, however, MR HAWTHORNE stated that he did not know if the manager intended to donate to the program or not.

One of the females with red hair then explained that she had been there three times and had not received any action yet. MR HAWTHORNE asked the girl if she could be reached at a telephone number and she wrote LINDA

THORNTON, ph. 281-3672, before him on a slip of paper and gave it to MR HAWTHORNE. The party then left and one of the men remarked, I hope he gets that phone number.

MR HAWTHORNE described the three girls as in their early twenties, all were short to medium height, one had orange hair, the other two wore bell bottom trousers and scarves and leather type jackets.

MR HAWTHORNE described the three men as approx. the same age as the girls, two wore Barry O hats and one had an Afro hairstyle with some type of a stick in it. Two were of moderate height and one was shorter. The shorter being a little more plump than the other two, and not shaven. This was the subject that made the remark re the manager getting the phone number.

The girl with the red hair carried a clipboard with the literature on the breakfast program on it.

The subjects left the Frito Lay and went next door to the Shur Fit Co. across Union Avenue from Frito Lay.

They were driving a 1966 Mustang, red, Oregon license GAX 634.

The witness, SANDRA GASKINS, informs that on 9/9/70 at approx. 1:05pm, she received a telephone call where a subject that sounded Negroid, said, tell the man we're going to blow them, and then hung up.

MR TODD, the manager of Frito Lay, advised me that he recently had a meeting with the Shur Fit Company and SEPH MARKS and the general manager of Lynn Kirby Ford. TODD said that he was told that the Shur Fit Company had given \$10 to the program and Lynn Kirby's general manager also gave \$10 and Seph Marks gave nothing.

I was informed by Sgt. Schwartz that Seph Marks, 2021 NE Union, phone 282-2261, received a ~~bomb~~ bomb threat at 9:40am this date.

When the three females and three males came in and solicited funds from MR HAWTHORNE, he wrote down the conversation as he remembered it as soon as these subjects left. A copy was made of the notes made by MR HAWTHORNE and they are ~~gt~~ with this report, and also a copy of the name and phone number written by LINDA THORNTON and left for the manager.

I contacted MR REY RUNNING of the City License Bureau and was informed that a request was received three weeks ago for application for a permit to solicit businesses for money for the three Black Panther clinics. MR RUNNING informs me that DICK HAROLD, one of the employees at the License Bureau,

did deliver the application by hand to 5255 N Vancouver. He gave the application to a Negro female whom MR HAROLD says he cannot identify.

The application has not been completed and returned, and a permit has not been issued for the soliciting.

MR RUNNING informs me that it is contrary to city ordinance to solicit funds for any charitable organization without such a permit.

contacted by a Negro female, approx 5' tall, weighing approx 100 lbs, 22-24 yrs of age with Afro styled hair with a red tint, who identified herself as Linda Thornton. He states that at the time Linda Thornton entered his place of business, she asked to speak to the owner of the business, and he stated that he was the manager. She advised him at this time that she and the group that was with her, which he described as mostly as young Negro male and females were interested in obtaining contributions from the businessmen in the area for their breakfast for school children program. She gave him a brochure, explaining their cause, and put her name, Linda Thornton, and a telephone #, 281-3672 and told him to call prior to 11 a.m. the next day, which would be Aug.21, 1970, re how much his contribution would be.

He states that during the entire time that he talked to her, the other subjects with her walked throughout the front portion of the store, handling merchandise, picking it up, slamming it down, slamming drawers, and giving him the feeling that he was being intimidated by their presence.

Marks states that he got together with the owner of the Sure Fit Auto Upholsterers, Frito-Lay Co. and Lynn Kirby Ford, all located in approx the same area, and discussed the problem with them, and all four stated that they had been contacted and Mr. Marks states they contacted the police dept. intelligence division, and Officer Beaudrius came out as a representative from the police dept., discussing their problem with them, and taking a report on the problem. All agreed amongst themselves to refuse to pay, however, Mr. Marks stated that he was later advised that the Sure Fit Auto Upholsterers Co. had given a contribution last month of \$10.

Apparently yesterday, the owner of Frito-Lay potato chip company contacted some type of Albina Minister's association to complain about the fact that the businessmen were being intimidated, in his opinion, to pay to the Breakfast for Children program, and that he felt it was being given the impression it was church related. Approx ½ hr later, according to Marks, the owner of Frito-Lay received a call back from the Ministerial Association, stating that they had checked into the problem, and were trying to correct this situation, however, shortly after this call was returned, Frito-Lay received a bomb threat, very similar to the one that Marks Motors had received this morning. A car was sent to Frito-Lay Co. and the bomb threat report written on the situation.

Marks states that it is still his intention to hold out against the threats, and to keep us advised of any further communication he has either in the form of threats or the return of anyone from this group asking for a contribution.

The handout from the Breakfast for School Children programs, with the name Linda Thornton and the telephone #, 281-3672, and the time of 11 a.m. written on it by Miss Thornton was taken as evidence and will be

On this date the writer talked to a gentleman who has considerable knowledge of the happenings of the Highland Community Center which is associated with the Highland United Church of Christ run by minister Sam JOHNSON. The writer shall call the informant Mr. X.

The Highland United Church of Christ which is run by Mr. Sam JOHNSON, negro, minister, is the overall head of the church and the four sub-divisions of the Highland Center as follows: The writer will point out that SAM JOHNSON does not have a Board of Directors, however he has been advised to have a board of directors for several years but at the present time JOHNSON still carries all the weight and the problems on his shoulders.

One of the four sub-divisions of the Highland Center is one that is called Hi-Park Enterprises, Inc. Its location is at 3539 NE Union. Though independently housed, the enterprise remains the project of the center and will continue to exist primarily for the betterment of conditions in the black community. It will have to make enough profit to pay its own way but its intent is to serve a community need, specifically a training ground for people who have found it difficult to get and hold jobs. One particular donation that was given to the Hi-Park Enterprises, Inc. was from a man by the name of WILLIAM KNIGHT, associated with the Oregonian newspaper. Mr. KNIGHT contributed \$2600.00 towards this center. Other persons of notoriety associated with this Highland center is Merl McKee of McKee Pontiac and Mr. Jack Day who was most recently an executive with Tektronix. Another sub-division of the center is called the Highland United Improvement Corporation. This is an alleged non-profit housing improvement association which rehabilitates housing in the community for sale to low-income families with low down payment and interest through the FHA 235J program. Followup counseling is also provided to help buyers learn to anticipate and handle their new responsibilities.

A third sub-division is called the ALFRED YAUN YOUTH CARE CENTER. This youth center is operated by a sister of SAM JOHNSON, the minister. Since the opening of this youth care center in May the committee has worked long and hard to secure state certification. This state approval was granted in November, giving the home one-half its operating costs up to \$125.00 per boy per month matching funds coming through Multnomah County Juvenile Court. HAROLD and REBECCA GRIFFITH have moved into the home as house parents. Former house parents GENE and BETTY MARSHALL are now in their own apartment and on their own. A Rev. RAY MAIER and DENNIS CONE are guiding the counseling program which will use volunteer professional counselors for regular individual and group sessions. Recreational opportuni-

ties are enhanced by the gift of a fine pingpong table from the Swan Island Naval Reserve station. (Attached to this report is a mimeographed four-page report, dated 12-16-69, states HIGHLAND CENTER HAPPENINGS).

The fourth sub-division is the Highland Sewing Center. This sub-division of the Highland center is repairing and renovating old clothing which will be suitable for the poor and the people who don't have enough.

The reader's attention is called to the fourth page and the writer will give a summation of this. It starts with the caption "Breakfast for needy children has been served by Black Panther members on school mornings. Though Rev. Johnson does not agree with the purposes and philosophy of the Black Panther organization, he does feel that many children of the community do not get enough to eat. Noone else has proposed to fill this need.

As long as the Panthers serve breakfast and do not use the occasion to indoctrinate the children with hateful philosophy they will be welcome to use the center however Rev. Johnson is fully aware that elsewhere the program has been abused and he will maintain careful watch as long as it uses the center's facilities.

Rev. Johnson asked us to accept the challenge to reach out to these youths and help meet some of their needs with love in order that they might be willing to put down the sword. Rev. Johnson goes on to state that he would like to state to those who are concerned about the breakfast program being sponsored by Black Panthers that many of these youths have been misused and abused not only by the church which failed to recognize their physical and personal needs but by also the social structure that continues to make them dependent rather than independent.

Rev. Johnson further states that the surest way to eliminate the hateful forces that motivate the Black Panther type of organization is to help them build self-respect in constructive ways. This is no easy task but it must be done if we do not wish to have the unsatisfactory alternative...retaliation. Noone hates happily. An ex-Panther, now holding a good job, no longer has time nor inclination for nursing hate.

Another two page brochure which will be attached to this report entitled "Primary Objective of the Black Panther Party to establish revolutionary political power for black people." Another attachment to this report is a brochure, one page, states "Ministry of Information, Bulletin No. 5". This is apparently from the Black Panther Party. Another enclosure which is the front page of the Black Panther newspaper, dated Saturday, January 3, 1970...this newspaper handed out to the schoolchildren at the Panther breakfasts from King Grade School. The reader will please note the several paragraphs that are outlined in pen. It is too filthy to dictate.

Mr. X feels that Rev. Johnson cannot control the Panthers, in other words he is afraid that there might be some repercussions on either

his personal safety or the church or the Highland Community Center. Further, Mr. X states that FRED WHITLOW, an associate of FORD, stated right in the Highland United Church of Christ several months ago fo several children that were there for their breakfast, "in school you are a Panther, don't listen to white teachers".

Further information was obtained that during a particular session at the Highland United Church of Christ KENT FORD was quizzed in regards to the bombing or the fire-bomb which was thrown in Kienow's some time ago. To quote KENT FORD's words "it was to teach them a lesson". Mr. X further stated his feelings that Sam JOHNSON, minister of Highland United Church of Christ, is playing both ends against the middle, that he will not obtain a board of directors but carries all the particular items and information within himself and on himself and that he does not want to hurt the feelings of the whites because that is where the money comes from and he doesn't want to hurt the feelings of the blacks because he still feels they are his people and his feelings that he is afraid to cut the Panthers off completely. Information has it that several churches, particularly white congregations contribute upwards of \$100 a month to the Highland Community Center which Sam JOHNSON is the president of or the leader.

While on routine patrol at approximately 2:21 am, undersigned officers were eastbound on NE Fremont and turning northbound on NE Union. At this time the undersigned officers observed a car and a green Chev pickup, late model, cross the intersection at Union and Fremont and continue eastbound. At this time the pickup slowed down while next to McDonald's, honked his horn as the undersigned officers made the left hand turn northbound onto Union. ~~Approx~~ Approx 5 to 10 seconds after making the turn and being on NE Union between Beech and Failing, heard a large explosion which shook the entire car. On turning around and looking back observed a cloud of white smoke ascending from the north side of the MacDonal'd's restaurant. Undersigned officers then proceeded to that location, sealed off the entire area, keeping the people away while extra police cars and fire dept were called. After the explosion a large group of people gathered in the area, however, we were able to keep them away from the scene. ID was then called along with Det Unit, #247 who ~~responded~~ responded and will write the crime against property report. Area was sealed off by the fire dept, the owner notified.

After the explosion, the burglar alarm at Lincoln Park Food located at 3536 NE Union, started sounding. However, this was accidental due to the intensity of the bomb going off that shook the entire area. Returned to service at 3:49 am.

SUMMARY

This report reflects the investigation of the bombing of McDonald's Hamburger Stand located at 3510 NE Union. Person (s) unknown laid an unknown explosive device against the side of the building which after detonation cause considerable damage to this building. Dist Car 73 in a routine check of the area had just passed by this business and was approx two blocks away when the explosion occurred. A canvass of the neighborhood by Uniform Officers failed to turn up any suspects.

NARRATIVE

Six: At 2:21 a.m. this date Dist Car 73 containing Officers Bracy and Shreck advised the police radio that a bombing had occurred at McDonalds at NE Union & Fremont. Sgt Frank Daggett of North Prec. and numerous Uniform Officers secured the scene pending our arrival. Also covering on this investigation was Inv. Petruzzelli of the Portland Fire Bureau. Ident. Officer Whitman also was present and took samples of material along with numerous photographs for future investigative needs.

Upon talking with Officers Bracy and Shreck it was learned by writer that they had approached the intersection of Union and Fremont, heading eastbound on Fremont, proceeded to make a left turn to go north on Union and approx two blocks after this turn was completed their car was jarred and they heard a very loud explosion. For details of their knowledge of this case, see their supplemental report.

Writers noticed immediately upon arriving at the area a strong pungent odor in the air. This odor reminded writers of a exploded fire cracker in a closed-in area. It was also noticed on observation that many of the windows on the north side of the building had been completely shattered and numerous portions of the outer tile, signs and lighting at this location had been damaged. The blast also caused some interior damage consisting of plaster being loosened from the wall near the blast area. The concussion was strong enough to throw metal-framed, outdoor-type table a distance of 6 to 8 ft away from the blast, and also to completely disengage the top which is bolted on to this frame by means of six bolts.

The unknown explosive is believed by writers not to be a timed device. A thorough search of the entire area surrounding this building by writers and the Uniform Officers proved negative for finding any type of timing or triggering device for the explosive. Officer Whitman of the I. D. Div. took numerous photographs and secured samples of various materials for possible leads to the exact type of explosive used. The explosive was laid against the wall on the north side of the building. Along a portion of the north wall there is built right into the building a bench type seating area. This is constructed of concrete with a ceramic tile finish. The explosive device was placed at ground level leaning in a corner of the building at the east end of this seat.

Writers made contact with a MR ALLEN D. KUNZ of 4239 NE 62nd, res ph 281-9002. He is the Ass't Mgr. of this McDonalds Hamburger stand and he normally works the swing shift relief. He informed the writers that on this particular evening a MR BILL DAVIS, ph 227-0957, was the Ass't Mgr on duty and was believed to have left the establishment between 1:30 and 2:00 o'clock a.m., 8-22-70. This business normally closes on Friday night at 1:00 o'clock a.m. MR KUNZ informed the writers that they have had threats in the past that some thing of

this nature would happen to their business, however, on this particular date, 8-21-70, they had received no threat. The normal picketing by the Black Panther element was conducted as usual during the business hours Friday.

Uniform Officers checked with the homes in the area for possible leads or suspects, this meeting with negative results.

Charge of the building was left to MR KUNZ as he is a representative of McDonalds.

He says that one of these men was carrying a bundle wrapped in brown butcher's paper that was about the right size and shape to contain 3 or 4 sticks of dynamite. When he noted this he asked his fellow security guard at McDONALDS get a license number for the persons automobile. Nothing more was thought of it until the bombing and Mr BROWN has been trying since then to get the license number from his co-worker. This man has not been available to his telephone at this time but Mr BROWN will contact him as soon as possible and relay the license number of the car. Mr. BROWN also stated that the manager of the McDONALDS restaurant was taking pictures of the picketing yesterday and is quite likely that he will have had a picture of the man with the bundle. Mr. BROWN feels that he would be able to identify this person.

Telephone call was received from Officer Tardiff of the Traffic Division. Officer Tardiff works part time for the Lampus store on Union Avenue and was talking to the druggist Mr ED HOLLAND. Mr HOLLAND told Tardiff that about 4 o'clock yesterday a white male, about 30 years old, 5-10, 180# came in and asked for 1 pound of potassium chloride. Mr. HOLLAND told this person they did not have such material available and the person left. Mr. HOLLAND told Tardiff that he recognized the person as having been in the store previously, went through his prescription logs and thinks the name might ALLEN MOGAN of 2138 SE Brooklyn. He is not sure that this is the name of the person that asked for the potassium chloride. MOGAN's name has been checked through Records with negative results.

Lt Smith at North Precinct was contacted and request made that officers from his precinct who canvassed the neighborhood immediately following this bombing write reports giving the addresses of all houses where they made contact and the results of those contacts. These reports will be forthcoming.

In contact with Record Division and was advised that on 8-11-70 Mr. LAVISKE was a complainant giving an address of 14414 NE Beech, phone 254-7116. We attempted to contact Mr. L LAVISKE but find that this phone has been disconnected, with no new number. Being unable to contact Mr LAVISKE regarding the pictures we proceeded to the Portland Sports Center where we contacted BILL JACKSON, Special Officer, who advises that he was the last subject that left the restaurant at approximately 2am. JACKSON states that prior to leaving he was involved in a conversation, he and his brother were talking to a man and a woman in a red pick up with Washington license, from Vancouver. She stated that there was absolutely nothing to see and she could not see damage to the building from where she was and that other than there had been a loud blast, there was nothing to indicate that anything was wrong until the police and the crowd showed up.

She stated that directly after the blast and prior to the police arriving, there was absolutely no one or no automobiles moving on the streets.

As reflected in an earlier confidential info report by this writer, writer did further check the two aside listed names and it is believed that the aforementioned EDWARD JOHNSON is the subject referred to by writer's informant as having previously threatened to be involved in a bombing or burning of the McDonalds establishment.

The second subject is the woman known to this detail as a check writer, among other things, who is supposedly currently residing with the JOHNSON subject south of Killingsworth on Williams Avenue in some green apartments.

The automobile mentioned in this report was observed by writer and Det. Stone while being gassed at the service station on the southeast corner of NE Williams and Fremont, this car being a red Falcon with front end damage.

bearing the aforementioned license. The prior information was that the JOHNSON subject was driving a red Falcon with front end damage, license unknown. It is not known if these are the same cars or not and it was impossible to determine, at the time of observation this afternoon, if the JOHNSON subject was driving the car when we saw it.

It should be noted that writer and Det. Stone did spend considerable time attempting to locate a red Falcon with front end damage in the vicinity of the Williams & Killingsworth area, however, with no avail.

At the next contact with this writer's informant, will positively either identify or eliminate the aforementioned JOHNSON as the subject referred to by the informant as being involved with the Panthers in the bombing situation.

While working Desk East Prec at 5:30pm was contacted by Mr Danish who stated that sometime during the week, a group from the Black Panthers Organization came in and left a pamphlet with his secretary. The pamphlet is describing Breakfast For School Children Program. He stated that they told his secretary that they would return to talk to him. Mr Danish stated that the subjects came in Thursday, 8-20-70 in the afternoon and that the four younger Negro subjects just walked around the office looking at things and the female subject asked him if he had seen their pamphlet that they had left, he stated that he hadn't had a chance to look at it

yet. She asked him if he would donate to the cause. Mr Danish stated at this time that he had not read it, that it would look into it and if it was a worthy cause he would consider donating. At this time the subjects turned to leave, and the stocky Negro male turned around and told him that, they would be back next week.

Mr Danish stated that Carlos next door had talked to him afterwards, and that the subjects had been into see him and that he was scared so ~~knuxknux~~ he donated \$10. The girl at this time, after he had donated \$10, asked him if he would donate \$10 next month. At this time Carlos stated that he did not know for sure. Carlos is sharing the body shop with Bills Paint Shop as described above.

Mr Danish stated that he had talked to his attorney and his attorney advised him to see the police and to talk ~~kn~~ with other ~~knuxknux~~ business men in the area. Mr Danish stated that he will be calling other businessmen in the area Monday and see about getting some sort of community meeting to do something about the soliciting in this manner for funds. Mr Danish was advised ~~kn~~ if they came back and questioned him again to give us a call and that to give us all the info he could about the second visit if one was made. The pamphlet that was left will be detained at East Prec.

Sir:

The writer received additional information by telephone from two owners of businesses in Portland as follows:

✓ Miss Kathy Walker, Secretary to Mr. Danish, who is the owner of the Jewel Glass Company, 2607 N. Vancouver, 282-3229, informed the writer that on August 20, 1970 two negro females and four negro males in their early twenties or less entered the Jewel Glass Company and stated they wanted donations for the children's breakfast fund.

Mr. Danish informed them that he would have to check with the particular church that the negroes wanted the check made out to and for the donation representatives to return next week and he would see what could be done.

✓ A Mr. Carlos Montoya, owner of the Carlos Body and Fender Company, located at 2609 N. Vancouver, 287-8529, called the writer on this date and stated that on August 20, 1970 two negro females and three or four negro males entered his place of business and stated they wanted a donation to the Children's Breakfast Fund and to write the check to the aforementioned church.

Mr. Montoya stated he was a little concerned and gave the donation committee a \$10 check. Further, Mr. Montoya stated that the representatives for this donation committee asked if he would contribute this every month. When Mr. Montoya stated he was not sure, one of the negroes who were in his place stated in so many words, "Man you'd better come up with it next month."

SUBJECT: Attempt extortion by Black Panthers.

On this date the writer was contacted by Mr. A. L. Todd, Owner and General Manager of the Frito-Lay Potato Chip Company located at 2045 E. Union, 288-5037 regarding an attempt extortion by members of the Black Panthers.

Mr. Todd stated that yesterday, August 20, 1970, three negro females described as in their early 20's, one particularly outstanding as the female had an orange wig on, confronted he and his manager with the proposition that they wanted donation for the Breakfast For Schoolchildren Program, a national committee to combat facism, that this donation would be picked up on August 21 by 11:00 o'clock (or else). One of the female subscribers stated her name was LINDA THORNTON and gave the phone number of 281-3672. (The writer checked this phonenumber with the telephone security and found it was listed to a DARLENE FISHER, 3935 N. Albina, occupation of cashier for Pacific Power and Light Company, further information that Miss or Mrs. Fisher has four telephone instruments at her residence. Checked with Portland Police Records and found that there is a warrant on file #F6928WA for the amount of \$250.00 charging Darlene Fisher with Disorderly Conduct. Darlene Fisher described as nbc female, 5'5", 112#, dob 2-22-49.) Mr. Todd went on to say that the people that asked him for a donation to this Breakfast For Schoolchildren program stated they wanted an answer by 11:00 o'clock this date and left the aforementioned phone number.

Other persons that attended this meeting with Mr. Todd were a Mr. William CROW who is in from Los Angeles and is in the process of purchasing the entire Frito-Lay complex on Union Avenue. Mr. Crow owns five or six other potato chip factories in Los Angeles.

Also at the meeting was Mr. Charles KIES. Mr. Kies is the owner of Sure-Fit, an auto upholstery shop located at 2046 NE Union Avenue, 288-5539. Mr. Kies stated that he felt that if he didn't donate they would burn his business down. He contributed \$10.00 several weeks ago and gave an additional \$10.00 yesterday. As the people left, one of them stated to Mr. Kies "we'll be back next month for more money". Another gentleman that attended this meeting was a Mr. Seth MARKS, owner of Earl Marks Company Auto Supply located at 2021 N. E. Union, 282-2261. Mr. Marks stated that he was confronted by five or six negro males and one female on August 20, 1970, that these negro males were handling everything in his store, making a general nuisance of themselves and stated they wanted donation and that he would call the aforementioned telephone number by 11:00 o'clock this date and inform them as to how much they would be given for the alleged Breakfast For Children program.

Mr. Seth Marks of the Earl Marks Company asked the writer near the finish of the meeting if he should have his employees work overtime and to arm them with shotguns in case these people came back to confront him if he did not make the donation.

In reply to Mr. Marks question, the writer told him not to have any of his employees armed, if he wanted to have the employees work overtime that was up to him but that this information would be forwarded to superior officers for this information and their dissemination.

A summation of all the businessmen attending this meeting on this date all were under the opinion that they would dearly like to get out of the Union Avenue district, sell their businesses, because they are afraid the businesses will be burned down or bodily harm will be inflicted on them or their employees. Most stated that this would be impossible to do because of the contracts, leases, and things of this nature. All the businessmen that were in this meeting felt the same way, that they would like to get out of the place and they wanted to know what could be done. Several of the businessmen commented in regards to arming their employees other than Mr. Marks. The writer stated that this would not be the proper action to take, that this would be a job for the police burca to handle and that the information obtained from this meeting would be forwarded to the Chief.

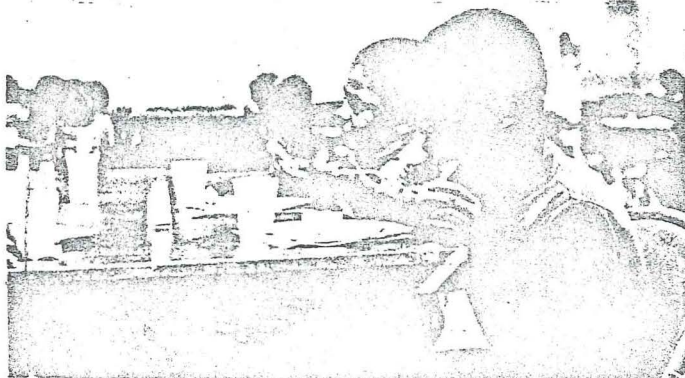

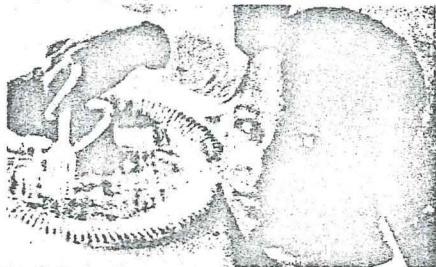
VICIOUS CHAIN...

You can't get the best jobs because you're uneducated, and you're uneducated because you didn't learn in school because you weren't interested. And every time the teacher mentioned 5 apple or 6 bananas, your stomach growled. How can a person learn about remainders and quotients when his mind is concentrating on a very real and concrete problem? Where is the next meal coming from? The Black Panther Party standing as a true representative of Black people's desires and needs, realizes that this vicious circle and chain of events must be broken, it cannot and must not be allowed to continue.



SERVE THE PEOPLE...

The Black Panther Party recognizes this vicious chain, and as our chairman, Bobby Seale says, "Revolutionaries must always go forth to answer the momentary desires and needs of the people, the poor and oppressed people, while waging the revolutionary struggle...We are concerned with the desires of the people and naturally the people are going to relate to what the Party is trying to put together for them. They will relate to the fact that the Party is really trying to serve them. We go down there to work, to put this program together. They become involved because they are community people, and there's not even



a preacher in any church (preachers have always brainwashed the Black people) who can deny a breakfast for children program. There's not a businessman nor a demagogic politician around who can deny a breakfast for children program and get away with it...

"A revolutionary organization has to maintain and righteously serve the people and not just jive them. And when the people see that we're not jiving they're going to relate to that. Because it's their program.

"As Huey has said, 'We are only like oxen to be ridden by the people. A strong detachment that the people can always use to serve them or when a crisis comes forth.'"

BREAK THE CHAIN!

The chain was broken: a free breakfast program was born in Oakland. The people under the leadership and guidance of the BLACK PANTHER PARTY smashed this evil chain, and moved to collectively feed their own children. Our party knew along with anyone else who had eyes to see and ears to listen, that our children were going hungry. But this is where our party differs from previous parties and groups. Our party took this basic desire and need of our people and brought it into reality working alongside the people.

A few moments later he had heard a clicking at the back door and at first ~~thought~~ thought it was a fan ~~which~~ which has given him problems in the past.

He had then located the sound as coming from the back door and had gone there and apparently spooked the subj away. However, this 2nd subj, the above #2

Compl stated that he had ~~was~~ noticed that there were picketers on the sidewalk area surrounding the restaurant however, he paid no attention to them as he wanted to make a purchase at that restaurant. The compl stated that he drove onto the lot and parked his veh and as he approached the McDonalds Restaurant area, 3 nbc's #1 wearing a tee shirt and described only as having a pot belly; #2 Afro hairdo with a comb stuck in the back; #3 wearing a pork-pie crushed hat. These subjs blocked the doorway into the restaurant and would not let the compl pass by. One of the subjs stated, "don't you know we are picketing McDonalds." He also stated, "you wkd would be smart not to go in this place." "If you do go in, something can happen to you." The compl stated that he replied, what's your problem. All I want to do is go in and get something to

The compl stated that the subjs started explaining how McDonalds was taking millions of dollars out of the community and how all that they were asking for was money for the Black Community Food Programs. The subjs stated that all the other merchants were cooperating with them. The compl stated that he replied, if you are so concerned with money, why don't you go out and get a job and contribute to whatever you want to. The compl stated that the subjs replied that they were Black, that they had no money and asked him for a dollar.

The compl stated that he went around the subjs and informed the McDonalds personnel of the threat whereupon they came out and discussed the matter with the nbc subjs whereupon they moved back from the doorway to restaurant.

The compl stated that he wished to make a compl due to the fact that he construed the nbc subjs remarks as a forceful threat to himself and his family. The compl stated that he can ID the three subjs if he sees them again. He stated he would be willing to sign a compl or testify against them, should the occasion arise.

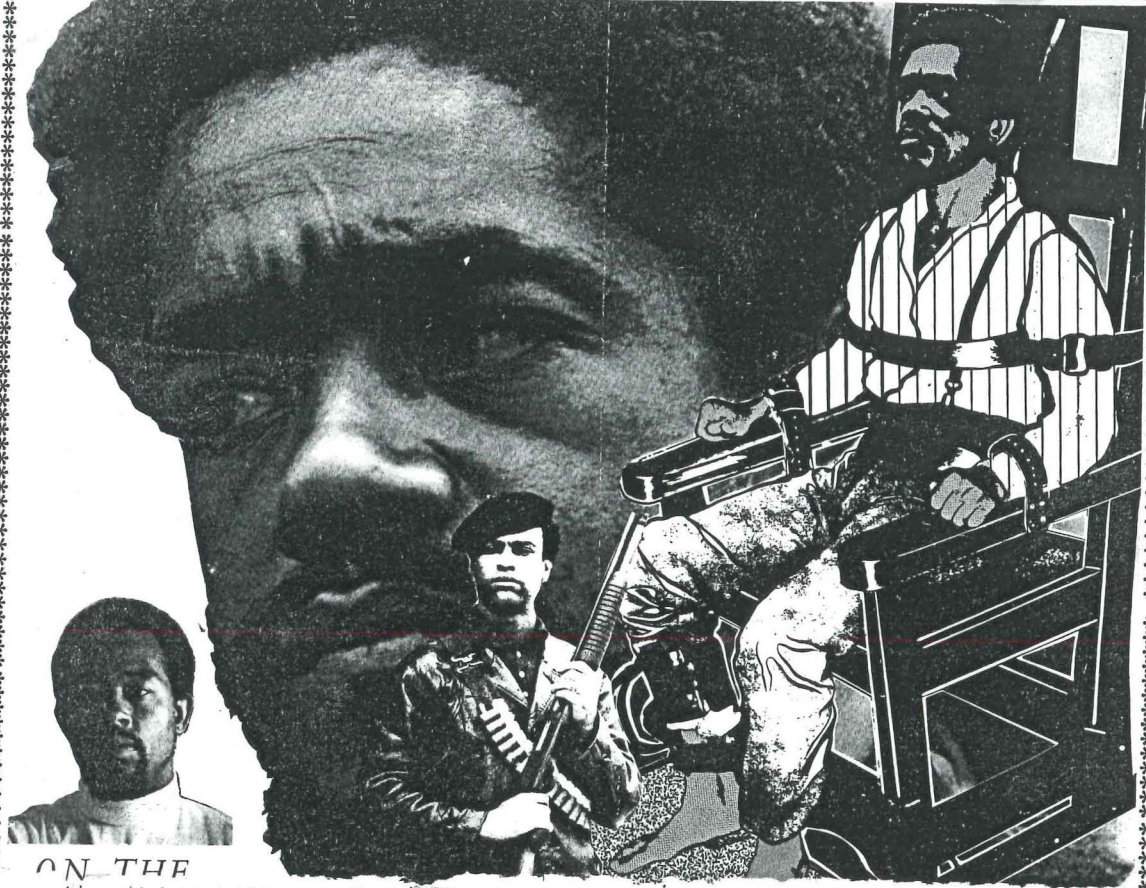
Officers drove by the McDonalds Restaurant after talking to the compl, however, could find none of the subjs described.

ON THE CONSTITUTION

ELDRIDGE CLEAVER MINISTER OF INFORMATION BLACK PANTHER PARTY U.S.A.

At this time the struggle of our people has reached classic proportions and we are going to have to deal with this in classic terms. Our struggle has deepened until the issues that control the society are the everyday issues of Black people. We've finally launched the spearhead of our attack into the very system of oppression itself. We challenge the entire system of oppression in Babylon and we've got it on a level now where it can be dealt with. There is no more hide-an-go-seek. The Black Panther Party has put the struggle of our people on a for-real level where there ain't no place for the oppressor to hide, because we confront the oppressor with Revolution. We confront the oppressor with the negation of everything about him, his entire system. Our freedom can only be based upon the negation of the system of oppression. And since our struggle is now on that level, we must deal with it in those terms.

What we need, at this time, is an over-all framework and structure to our struggle so that everybody can see how we can move.

The Black Panther Party has totally and unequivocally indicted the system of oppression in Babylon, and we've proposed a method for dealing with the system; and we must also begin to articulate a rational and positive alternative to the system. It is not enough just to say that we're going to have Socialism, or that we're going to change this decadent Capitalist system. We must also point out that we want Socialism and how we go about getting it. And we must be able to deal with the structure of society and the instruments that hold that structure together. And at the bottom of the structure of oppression in Babylon is the American Constitution.

The U.S. Constitution is the battlefield on which the struggle of our people for their liberation is taking place. The Supreme Court interprets the law of the land according to the Constitution. The Constitution is the ultimate source of authority, the ultimate repository of the collective sovereignty of the people. It is the place where the collective sovereignty of the people has been gathered together. And the Constitution is supposed to represent a just and equitable organization of our collective sovereignty in a form that will guarantee us a good life and liberty and the pursuit of happiness. And we have not received this.

So our challenge is a constitutional challenge. We challenge the Constitution of the United States of America. And we're saying that there's something wrong in Babylon, and the form of its organization is based upon the U.S. Constitution, and we must change this form of the system, and we must change the Constitution.

I anticipate the same type of reaction from a lot of napes that we got from our call for a United Front Against Fascism. But by the backsliding that these people do, they only guarantee and they only prove the Black Panther

Party right once again—they guarantee that the United Front Against Fascism will be erected in the streets, by the people, with arms in their hands. Because they made it impossible for any other form of United Front Against Fascism to come about. And they will always do this, and they will do this with our call for a REVOLUTIONARY PEOPLE'S CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION, to be convened by the people, and pigs have no say.

I think that we can do a little research on American history and check out the Constitutional Conventions that have been held in the past, after the liberation of the colony from British Imperialism. And the way that power has been apportioned in Babylon, I've been thinking, we can attack. We can make a valid attack with which to educate the people. We can attack the Great Compromise, which structured the American Congress and created the Senate and the House. This was supposed to balance off those states with large populations against those states that had small populations so that each state was given two senators and all the other power was apportioned out on a numerical basis, according to the population. So many people meriting one representative in Congress. This is one of those so-called checks and balances that they talk so much about that keep Black people in check while White people balance off their power against us, and exploit us, murder us, and deny us our life and our humanity. This is one of those checks and balances. And this is really the trick bag in American history. They like to call it the genius of the American System because it provides them with an instrument of rule. This is why they say that democracy in America has been perfected under the American form of electoral system.

And if you notice, the historic nature of the U.S. Senate, this is the instrument through which the ruling class guarantees its power and guarantees its control of the American government. Our oppressors have been Senators, Senator Johnson, Senator Kennedy, Senator Eastland, Senator Strom Thurmond, Senator Talmage, Senator Stennis, Senator Humphrey, Senator Knowland, Senator Goldwater, Senator Brooks. These are the higher echelon of the Demagogic Politicians. These are the Watchdogs of Babylon, the Guarddogs of Babylon. These pigs. And they're a different form of target than the more numerous populated House of Representatives.

The House of Representatives is more representative than the Senate, and it doesn't represent us.

I say that we challenge the structure of the U.S. Government and we propose to change the structure of this government by holding another Constitutional Convention so that we can all be represented. Black people can pick their own representatives. Where young people, who are the majority in Babylon, can have some form of representation guaranteed, instead of all these old decrepit

witches deciding our destiny. And we know that these pigs will not give us a Constitutional Convention. So that the struggle for the Constitutional Convention becomes part and parcel of our struggle for liberation. In fact, it becomes synonymous with our struggle for liberation because you can't have one without the other. We have a right to a Constitutional Convention when the people call for one. The people of Babylon have become alienated from the atrocious, oppressive government that's in the hands of a vicious, exploitative ruling class.

The ruling class will not allow it, but we have a right to a Constitutional Convention and we will fight for our rights.

So we call for a REVOLUTIONARY PEOPLE'S CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION.

This is actually the implementation of Point No. 10 of the Black Panther Party's Platform and Program. In Point No. 10 we state that we call for a U.N. Supervised Plebiscite to be held amongst Black People so that we can go on record determining our own destiny. And we stated that this is our major political goal.

Now it's very clear that we have a position on the *CC, on a *RPCC, and what we're saying is that we are either going to have our full freedom and liberation within the structure that succeeds Babylon, or we want out of it. We're not going to accept less than our full freedom and liberation and remain inside of it peacefully. So either we're going to change Babylon, restructure it along humanistic lines, or we implement that portion of Point No. 10 that relates to moving on the international level--The Black Plebiscite.

We're speaking about the form that our struggle must take and the direction that we move in, like a target to aim at. Because we have to liberate ourselves from this offensive power structure. We have to wage a People's War against the oppressive system and its mercenaries, and we will do this, and we will be victorious, and we will have a *CC, a *RPCC. But we don't wait until after the victory takes place before we start thinking and talking about how we move, what we will do. Because it is all part of the process of getting there—knowing where you're going.

We're opening up the hidden history, opening up Babylon to a full examination. We've already diagnosed it as a fatal cancer called Capitalism, Fascism, and Imperialism. It will all become much clearer when we start talking about changing the documents and the structure of the mechanism and the documents that control.

MESSAGE TO AMERICA

Delivered On The 107th Anniversary
Of The Emancipation Proclamation
At Washington, D.C. Capitol of Babylon,
World Racism, And Imperialism June 19, 1970
BY THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY

s oppressed people held captive within the confines of Fascist-Imperialist United States of America, we Black Americans take a dim view of the position that we, the people, find ourselves in at the beginning of the 7th decade of the Twentieth Century.

We find ourselves in a very dangerous world-situation. The America has always adhered to a very racist attitude towards its policy towards people who have color. This has been true in the past and it is true today. We see very clearly that whereas White America has escalated its policy of repression and containment of Black people inside the United States itself, on a world scale, the United States is playing the leading role in organizing the White race against the people of the world who have a color. Resolutions, contradictions between White Protestants and White Catholics, between White Christians and White Jews, between White Capitalists and White Communists, between White Eastern Europeans and White Western Europeans, between White Archeo-Colonialists and White Neo-imperialists, wherever we look, the picture is one and the same. White racist America, which domestically has followed the policy of open fascism in order to put down uprisings of oppressed people of color and those few Whites who take a stand against the grizzly reality of the Babylonian scene. This same White racist American

is still the same within the domestic confines of the United States of America, we see clearly that a well-planned, premeditated Fascist Genocidal Conspiracy is being implemented against our people.

Black people within the domestic confines of the U.S.A. have reached another cross road. This is a time for the most serious decisions that we, as a people, have ever been called upon to make. The decisions that we make in our lives, the actions that we take or fail to take, will determine whether we, as a people, will survive or fall victims to colonial extermination at the hands of the FASCIST IMPERIALISM which the Nixon clique are rapidly mobilizing against a beastly vigilantly weapon to be unleashed against

by President Abraham Lincoln of THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION during the Civil War, officially dated January 1, 1863. The end result of the EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION was supposed to be the freedom and liberation of Black people from the cruel shackles of chattel slavery. And yet, 100 and 7 years later, today, Black people still are not free. Where is that freedom supposedly granted to our people by THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION and guaranteed to us by the Constitution of the United States?

Is it in the many "Civil Rights Bills" that have been passed to try to hide the irrelevance of the Constitution for Black People?

Is it in the blood-shed and lives lost by Black People when America brings "Law and Order" to the ghetto in the same fashion and by those same forces that export "Freedom and Democracy" to Korea, to Vietnam, to Africa, Asia, and Latin America?

Is it the right to "political activity" when the U.S.A. attempts to legally murder Bobby Seale, Chairman of the Black Panther Party, for his political beliefs?

Where was that right when brother Malcolm was murdered, when Martin Luther King was gunned down?

Where is Freedom when a peoples right to "Freedom of Speech" is denied to the point of murder? When attempt

is to "freedom when the right to "peaceful assembly" brings on massacres? Where is our right to "keep and bear arms" when Black People are attacked by the Racist Gestapo of America? Where is "religious freedom" when places of worship become the scene of shoot-ins and bomb-ins? Where is the right to vote "regardless of race or color" when murder takes place at the voting polls? Are we free when we are not even secure from being savagely murdered in our sleep by policemen who stand blatantly before the world but yet go unpunished? Is that "...equal protection of the laws"? The empty promise of the Constitution to "establish Justice" lies exposed to the world by the reality of Black Peoples' existence. For 400 years now, Black people have suffered

our Social Rights. It does not even guarantee and protect our most basic Human Right, the right to LIVE!

IMPLEMENTING POINT NO. 10 OF THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY PLATFORM AND PROGRAM

Point No. 10 of the Black Panther Party's Platform and Program addresses itself to the question of the National Destiny of Black people. We feel that, in practical terms, it is time for Black people as a whole to address their attention to the question of our National Destiny.

Black people can no longer either respect the U.S. Constitution, look to it with hope, or live under it. The Constitution is the social contract that binds the American people together into a sovereign nation and defines authority and the distribution of power, rights, and privileges. By shoving the Constitution aside, rendering it null and void, in order to carry out fascist oppression and repression of Black people, the fascists have, by that very fact, destroyed even the false foundations of authority in this society. We live in a lawless society where racist pigs have usurped the Legislative, Judicial, and Executive branches of government and perverted them towards the miserability of their private interests. We repudiate, most

of all documents, laws, constitutions, and charters, the Constitution of the United States.

For us, the case is absolutely clear: Black people have no future within the present structure of power and authority in the United States under the present Constitution. For us, also, the alternatives are absolutely clear: the present structure of power and authority in the United States must be radically changed or we, as a people, must extricate ourselves from entanglement with the United States.

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racists lines. Within the domestic confines of the United States of America, we see clearly that a well-planned, calculated Fascist Genocidal Conspiracy is being implemented against our people.

Black people within the domestic confines of the U.S.A. have reached another cross road. This is a time for the most serious decisions that we, as a people, have ever been called upon to make. The decisions that we make in our time, the actions that we take or fail to take, will determine whether we, as a people, will survive or fall victims to genocidal extermination at the hands of the FASCIST MAJORITY which the Nixon clique are rapidly mobilizing into a beastly vigilantly weapon to be unleashed against us.

THE U.S.A. MONSTER

The United States of America is a barbaric organization controlled and operated by avaricious, sadistic, blood-thirsty thieves. The United States of America is the Number One exploiter and oppressor of the peoples of the whole world. The inhuman capitalistic system which defines the core of reality of the U.S.A., is the root of the evil that has polluted the very fabric of existence within the U.S.A. Exploitation of man by man; the rule of man over man instead of the rule of the laws of Human Rights and Justice; savage wars of aggression, mass murder, genocide, and shameless slaughter of the people of the world; impudent, arrogant White Racism; and a naked, brazen attempt to perpetuate White Supremacy on a world scale--these are a few of the unsavory characteristics of the U.S.A. Monster with which we have to deal.

We did not ask for this situation. We did not create it. And we do not prefer it but we must deal with it.

THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION

Today, June 19th, is the anniversary of the issuance

by President Abraham Lincoln of THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION during the Civil War, officially dated January 1, 1863. The end result of the EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION was supposed to be the freedom and liberation of Black people from the cruel shackles of chattel slavery. And yet, 100 and 7 years later, today, Black people still are not free. Where is that freedom supposedly granted to our people by THE EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION and guaranteed to us by the Constitution of the United States?

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THE CONSTITUTION

The Constitution of the U.S.A. does not and never has protected our people or guaranteed to us those lofty ideals enshrined within it. When the Constitution was first adopted we were held as slaves. We were held in slavery under the Constitution. We have suffered every form of indignity and imposition under the Constitution, from economic exploitation, political subjugation, to physical extermination.

We need no further evidence that there is something wrong with the Constitution of the United States of America. We have had our Human Rights denied and violated perpetually under this Constitution--for hundreds of years. As a people, we have received neither the Equal Protection of the Laws nor Due Process of Law. Where Human Rights are being daily violated there is denial of Due Process of Law and there is no Equal Protection of the Law. The Constitution of the United States does not guarantee and protect our Economic Rights, or our Political Rights, nor

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the Constitution of the United States. For us, the case is absolutely clear: Black people have no future within the present structure of power and authority in the United States under the present Constitution. For us, also, the alternatives are absolutely clear: the present structure of power and authority in the United States must be radically changed or we, as a people, must extricate ourselves from entanglement with the United States.

If we are to remain a part of the United States, then we must have a new Constitution that will strictly guarantee our Human Rights to Life, Liberty, and the Pursuit of Happiness, which is promised but not delivered by the present Constitution. We shall not accept one iota less than this, our full, unblemished Human Rights. If this is not to be, if we cannot make a new arrangement within the United States, then we have no alternative but to declare ourselves free and independent of the United States. If it is our national destiny to follow the latter course, then we must declare ourselves into self-governing machinery, and seek the recognition of the freedom-loving nations of the world.

The Black Panther Party fully realizes that the two roads open to us as set forth above involve monumental undertakings. But we are trapped in a monstrous situation that requires a monumental solution. And no task, however great, is too much to deal with when the very welfare, survival, and national destiny of our people are at stake. Having already struggled up from the dismal depths of chattel slavery, no obstacles can be too high for us to surmount in order to liberate our people and take back the freedom and security that was taken away from us and denied us for so long.

CALL FOR A REVOLUTIONARY PEOPLE'S CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

The hour is late and the situation is desperate. As a

nation, America is now in the middle of the greatest crisis in its history. The Black Panther Party believes that the American people are capable of rising to the task which history has laid before the nation. We believe that the American people are capable of rejecting the fascist solution to the national crisis which the fascist Nixon clique, the George Wallaces', Lester Maddoxes', Ronald Reagans', Spiro Agnews', etc. hold out to the people.

WE THEREFORE, CALL FOR A REVOLUTIONARY PEOPLE'S CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION, TO BE CONVENED BY THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, TO WRITE A NEW CONSTITUTION THAT WILL GUARANTEE AND DELIVER TO EVERY AMERICAN CITIZEN THE INVIOLEABLE HUMAN RIGHT TO LIFE, LIBERTY, AND THE PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS!

We call upon the American people to rise up, repudiate, and restrain the forces of fascism that are now rampant in the land and which are the only real obstacles standing between us and a rational resolution of the national crisis.

We believe that Black people are not the only group within America that stands in need of a new Constitution. Other

avaricious wars of aggression, our neglected elderly people all have an interest in a new Constitution that will guarantee us a society in which Human Rights are supreme and Justice is assured to every man, woman, and child within its jurisdiction. For it is only through this means that America, as a nation, can live together in peace with our brothers and sisters the world over. Only through this means can the present character of America, the purveyor of exploitation, misery, death, and wanton destruction all over the planet earth, be changed.

WARNING TO AMERICA

We are from 25 to 30 million strong, and we are armed. And we are conscious of our situation. And we are determined to change it. And we are unafraid. Because we have our guarantee. If the American people, as a whole, do not rise up, reverse the present course of this nation, which, if unchecked, holds out only fascist repression and genocide for Black people, then we, Black people, will be forced to respond with a form of War of Salvation that in the chaos of carrying it out and the attempt to repress it, will gut this country and utterly destroy it. Before we accept Genocide, we will inflict Total Destruction upon Babylon.

It had best be understood, now, that the power we rely upon ultimately, as our only guarantee against Genocide at the hands of the Fascist Majority, is our strategic ability to lay this country in ruins, from the bottom to the top. If forced to resort to this guarantee, we will not hesitate to do so.

TOWARDS A NEW CONSTITUTION

A Constitutional Convention is extremely important at this time because we must redefine and clarify our actions and our future plans as well as make known to the people and to the world the justification of our struggle against bureaucratic capitalism and American Imperialism.

The Civil Rights Struggle is no more than an extension of the American Revolution of 1776. Everyone should realize this, and with that realization we will come to the conclusion that those things that were gained by the White population of 1776 by separating itself and forming a nation - in other words of de-colonizing from England - gained them autonomy and also the Human Rights that they were seeking at that time.

I emphasize that this was 1776 when White people of America gained Human Rights. This was truly a revolutionary struggle. Unfortunately, Blacks, because of racism in the country and the fact of Slavery were not included in these rights. So, after this, we had the Civil Rights Movement, in order to gain those rights that Whites gained in 1776. Some two hundred years have passed and we haven't gained those basic rights.

Of course, the country wasn't revolutionized even though there was a revolutionary movement. It was not revolutionized simply because production wasn't at the stage where a socialist development was encouraged by the other forces. In other words, after the separation from England, democratic capitalism came into being. There was much land to be had and farmed. It was basically an agricultural country and very little industry. So people could compete with each other in somewhat of a democratic fashion. A man could have the wealth that he earned through planting the soil. And there was much available soil. Of course, I emphasize again that Blacks were not included in this.

When Blacks were not included in the first stage of development - the democratic capitalistic era. In our time - around 1970 - the country is not only fully developed, but it is overdeveloped. The economy is overdeveloped, the industry is overdeveloped. The ruling class of the country no longer invests its surplus capital in the country. This brings us to the imperialistic era, where the capitalist is now investing his surplus in the developing countries of the Third World, in order to gain a profit, because there is no room for expansion inside of this mature economy.

While all of this is happening, Blacks are still struggling for basic human rights: the right to vote, the right for economic well-being etc. We cannot gain our political liberties without the economic freedom. We cannot be integrated into the capitalistic system, because even if we had the wealth or the surplus capital to invest, there would be no market. There is no fertile market in which to invest. Not inside of this country.

I would like to backtrack a little to the period of 1863, 1865, after the Emancipation Proclamation and then the so-called Reconstruction. The Freedman's Bureau was established during the Reconstruction in order to allot one of the chief points argued in Congress by Thaddeus Stevens, that Blacks be allotted forty acres and a mule. Because without the land it was realized that there would be no freedom. But this did not occur. I would like to emphasize this to show that America has compromised our freedom again and again. The Hayes Compromise of 1877 devastated the whole Reconstruction period and the few crumbs that we'd gained during that period.

So I refer to a time when we've been forced out of the society, we've been forced out of equal protection of the law, and human respect. And it leaves us with nothing to lose, really, and everything to gain, because we've lost everything. And, of course, when one has lost everything, nothing is open to him but Total Rebellion. Rebellion against that force and those conditions which have stripped him of his very dignity as a human being.

What are the alternatives? We've concluded that there's no room for us in the capitalistic system, because of the overdeveloped nature of the country. We see that as far as autonomy of our community in any respect, as far as self-governing our institutions; this cannot exist under capitalism either because capitalism, the capitalistic system, is dictated by the small ruling class, approximately 76 companies that control the whole industry and the whole wealth of this country. That's General Motors, Ford, Chrysler, General Dynamics, Lockheed, Standard Oil, DuPont, Chase Manhattan Bank, Bank of America, and so on down the line.

The only way that we can now get freedom is to change that system that led us into slavery. We were brought into slavery because of profit for the slave driver and the capitalist. So we must change the very system. We don't only

one assortment of people, will receive the benefits and the wealth of the country.

Black people in this country, after such a long period of suffering because of capitalism and racism, have a right to exclusively control the institutions of the Black community. All other ethnic groups will also control their community in a co-operative fashion. And the national enterprises - what I call national enterprises are those big monopolies - will be nationalized so that each ethnic group will have a representative on the various boards. But those other ethnic groups, members of ethnic groups, who live in our communities, will be able to participate in a democratic fashion, because racism will be dead. But also we will maintain the right to have this Proportional Representation because the trust has been lost because of racism. Black people have lost faith--faith in this country. And for a safeguard, at least we'll have to have exclusive control over our local communities.

If we can't bring these things about, then, of course, we will be accepting Reactionary Suicide, or suicide caused by the reactionary conditions. I stand against it, if I have a choice, which I do, and if it comes to the point where there's only one choice - either to accept Reactionary Suicide or Revolutionary Suicide, then I would accept Revolutionary Suicide.

I think it goes without saying that Blacks are perfectly justified in declaring a Republic or a Liberated Territory, if we find that we cannot, through some mutual coalition,

bring about this type of Pluralistic Society that is desired. The only other alternative is to declare a Republic, and, as I said, face the cowardly imperialistic army, and thereby either defeat them or suffer Revolutionary Suicide.

so many ways, killed spiritually, killed through lack of basic needs - medicine, food for the kids, all these things that are so basic we don't even have to argue whether we're due them.

As revolutionaries, I would like to point out, to clarify our catechism, that we have been completely crushed as members of this so-called civilization. And when I say completely crushed, as revolutionaries, we have not only rejected a seat by the oppressor - those seats that he offers are merely crumbs - we also reject the ordinary - I say ordinary for lack of a better word - kind of family arrangements that are offered us, because that too is a compromise. What I'm saying is that we have to compromise even to have a wife and kids and a house and any kind of job or work. It's a compromise for Southern Blacks. It's a compromise for them to just live as every man has a right to live with a family and his loved ones, because the bourgeois state lays down the conditions under which you can have a family. In other words; if I were to accept a family, then I would accept this family under conditions that have been prescribed by the capitalists. I would have to accept the conditions of poverty, if I live in the South of worms in my kids stomachs, a lack of food, a lack of clothing. If I have to live in the urban areas of Harlem, I have to accept, in order to have a family, a compromise and have the kind of family that they have prescribed, the kind of family that is bitten by rats, that sleeps in housing that is unfit for human beings.

So as revolutionaries we not only reject these seats by the oppressor, we've also rejected the normal - when I say "normal" it's again for lack of a better word - we can't accept even the primary relationship of that nucleus family. And we're very angry because we can't accept these things. Because every man is due it. We're very angry, so therefore we're left out in the twilight zone with hatred for those conditions and those people who cause the conditions. Matter of fact, we have such strong feelings until we won't rest and we won't feel that we have done our job until we've lashed out and crushed those people and those conditions that won't allow us to have even the basic things that every man on the face of the earth has a right to have. That is a home, a family, and kids. To have a family we have to accept kids that are infected with racism, the conditions of racism, from the very moment he becomes conscious. So this is why we're strictly, as the Minister of Information has said, we're outlaws, we're outside even the law of humanity because we think that we've been dehumanized. But because we've been dehumanized we've become very dangerous people, dangerous to those who won't let us be human.

I would add that it must always be remembered, understood, and realized, that our one goal is to crush American Capitalism and American Imperialism. Because without this, we can do nothing.

BY INFORMATION FROM INFORMANT AND OUR OWN OBSERVATIONS, FORDS RESIDES AT THIS ADDRESS WITH HIS GIRLFRIEND.

AT THIS POINT INFORMANT HAD WITH HIM IN HIS AUTO AN OLD SHOTGUN AND AN OLD .22 REVOLVER. HE OFFERED THE GUNS TO FORD. FORD DECLINED THE GUNS AT THAT TIME TELLING INFORMANT THAT HE SHOULD KEEP THE GUNS FOR HIS OWN USE TEMPORARILY. 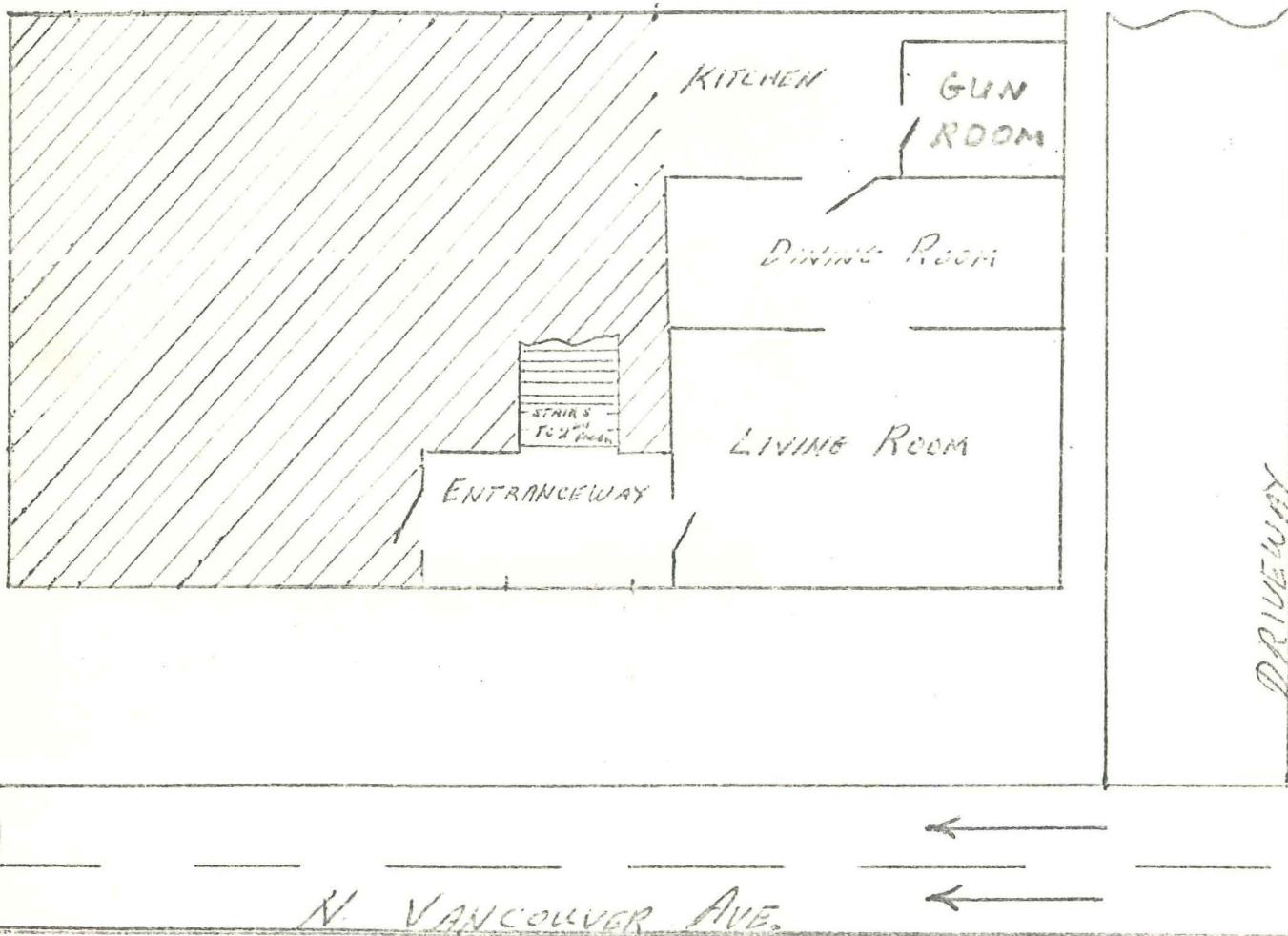
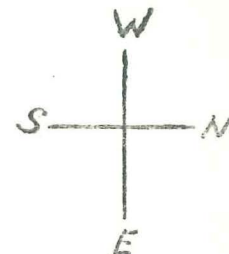

For white kids, police hassles are a drag. They search our cars without a warrant on Friday and Saturday nights if it looks like we're having fun. They "clean-up" the parks for Ivancic, the guy who makes it happen--to us! Sometimes, when we actually disturb the machinery that they use to keep us in line, like we did at FSU and at the Induction Center, they come down harder and smash our heads.

For blacks, the police are a much more serious problem. When the police are patrolling Albina, they are an occupying army and behave as such. There is very little love lost between City Hall and the black community. The police in Albina know that they have the support of Schruck and Ivancic when they behave like racist animals. Last summer, at the start of the Rose Festival the higher ups in the city decided that a show of force was necessary in the ghetto. And there was a riot, a police riot.

The police drove around Albina, arresting hundreds of young blacks. They brandished shotguns, called blacks by racist slurs that don't bear repetition, and tried to frame Black Panther Kent Ford on a charge of "riot."

The trial took place in February. The police, among them Clyde Harmon, lied blatantly, contradicting themselves so often that even an all-white jury couldn't bring down a conviction. The police were enraged at this failure of "law and order." They immediately stepped up harrassment of the black community. A week later, Stan Harmon, brother of Clyde, broke into the Panther office and shot 19 year old Albert Williams twice, and seriously endangered his life by delaying his medical treatment.

In typical police style, they turned the truth around and charged Albert with assault with intent to kill. The actual facts will come out at the trial. Come and hear the story for yourself, see what kind of "justice" is dispensed to blacks and young people in Portland courts. There will be a demonstration on the day Albert's trial opens, Tuesday June 30th. People are gathering at noon in the park across from the Multnomah County Courthouse (SW 4th & Main). People should also try to go to the sessions of Albert's trial, every day starting at about 9:30 am. When the police come down on any of us, black or white, we have to react as if they had attacked us all. Demand freedom for Albert Williams and for all political prisoners!!

Subject: AFRICAN LIBERATION DAY PARADE

Sir: The African Liberation Day Parade was held on May 27, 1978. It began at 1:00 P.M. at the Martin Luther King facility, N.E. 8th and Alberta, and proceeded to Irving Park.

The permit for the parade was asked for by Mr. Ronnie Herndon of the Black Educational Center, 4919 N.E. 17th. In the past Mr. Herndon has applied for parade permits for the same event.

Last year Sandra Ford, the wife of Kent Ford, applied for the parade permit. This year both Sandra and Kent Ford were in the parade and were organizers. Kent Ford used to be the head of the local Black Panther Party Chapter.

There were approximately 100 participants in the parade, of which 50 were little kids. It should be noted that this year there were only approximately 2 white people in the parade, where as last year the Revolutionary Communist Party took over the parade and there was a small minority of black people for participants.
