An Ordinance to vacate a part of Wabash Avenue in the City of Portland.

WHEREAS, due notice was given by advertisement for four consecutive weeks in the official newspaper of the City of Portland, to wit: "The Portland Daily Abstract," that at a regular meeting of the Council of said City to be held on the 22d day of December, 1909, a petition would be presented to said Council by the City of Portland, praying for the vacation of a part of Wabash Avenue in the City of Portland from its intersection with the south line of Pippin Street to its intersection with the north side line of Willamette Boulevard, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, which notice, with due proof of its publication, is filed with the Auditor of said City; and,

whereas, said petition was duly advertised and presented to the said Council on the date named in said notice, and within named, which petition duly sets forth the description of said avenue sought to be vacated, and the reason for such vacation, to which there was appended as a part thereof and as a basis for said vacation and for the granting of the prayer of said petition, the consent of the owners in fee simple of more than two-thirds of the real estate fronting on both sides of said portion of said street which is proposed to be vacated, estimated on the frontage of said avenue, such frontage commencing at a line drawn equi-distant

be vacated and extending along such proposed vacation the entire length thereof and extending 200 feet from the termini thereof in the direction in which said street is continuous, as required by Sections 362, 363 and 364 of the Charter of the City of Portland, which consent was in writing and was duly acknowledged before a Notary Public for the State of Oregon, and filed with the Auditor of said City; and,

WHEREAS, the said Council, upon the presentation of the said petition and filing of the proof of said notice, did fix a meeting of said Council on Wednesday, the 23d day of August, 1911, as the regular time and place for hearing said petition, and objections if any be filed thereto; and,

WHEREAS, on said 23d day of August, 1911, the time for considering said petition and objections, if any there be, was continued until the 13th day of September, 1911; and,

whereas, no objection to said petition or to the granting of the prayer thereof, or to the vacation of said portion of said avenue, had been filed; and,

whereas, said Council has ascertained and determined, and does hereby cause it to be made a matter of record, that the consent of the property owners of the requisite number of front feet fronting on said portion of said avenue and for the entire distance thereof, and 200 feet from the termini thereof, in the direction in which said street is continuous, has been duly obtained, and that the Public's interests would not be prejudiced by the vacation of said portion of said avenue sought to be vacated, and the Council so finding; now, therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That all of that part of Wabash Avenue, in the City of Portland, lying between the east line of Wabash Avenue and a line twenty (20) feet west therefrom, and between the west line of Wabash Avenue and a line twenty (20) feet east therefrom, from the south line of Pippin Street to the north line of Willamette Boulevard, (reducing the width of said Wabash Avenue between the points above mentioned from one hundred (100) feet to sixty (60) feet in width), be and the same is hereby vacated.
