Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- This ordinance will authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the City of Portland and Metro, to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant in the amount of \$663,000 for the development of six active transportation projects
- The following projects will be developed, scoped, and estimated: Connected Lents, Connected Division-Midway, Connected Cully Phase 2, 148th Ave Safety & Access to Transit, Stark/Washington Corridor Improvements (SE 92nd-108th), and the I-84 Multi-Use Path Extension (I-205 Path-122nd)

Financial and budgetary impacts:

 This IGA allows PBOT to receive \$663,000 of project development funding from Metro

Community impacts and community involvement:

- Improving safe and convenient active transportation routes has long been a priority in the six focus areas listed above
- Development will build on past planning efforts and community involvement, including work done through East Portland in Motion, Growing Transit Communities, Division-Midway Neighborhood Street Plan, and the Cully Local Street Plan
