August 23, 2018 Scope of Work and Cost

- Provide 10 hours school-based Bicycle Safety Education at up to 24 partner elementary and middle schools.
- Support PBOT staff in planning and delivering "train the trainer" for teachers on delivering the bicycle safety education curriculum to their students.
- Manage and maintain PBOT's Safe Routes bicycle fleet (250+ bicycles), including but not limited to the following:
 - Deliver and retrieve up to 35 bicycles and sufficient helmets to and from partner schools
 - Ensure bikes used for BSE and summer programming are in safe working condition
- Engage volunteers to support the community rides that culminates BSE and to maintain the bicycle fleet. Identify and employ strategies to increase diversity of volunteers.
- Co-create agenda and attend a monthly education staff meeting and a coordinator meeting with PBOT.
- Participate in training and teambuilding as approved by PBOT.
- Promote program accomplishments and work with instructors to provide stories, photos and material to PBOT.
- Provide monthly written invoice with report detailing number of students served, volunteer participation, bicycle fleet status and qualitative updates on school partnerships.
- Complete year-end report that summarizes The Street Trust delivery of PBOT's bicycle safety education program.
- Partner with PBOT to identify strategies to help with transition of BSE to middle school aged students.
- When specified by PBOT, research and document other contractor- and partnerprovided program offerings in schools that might use delivery strategies that would be effective for mobility education

- Collaborate on development of evaluation tools for new curriculum
- Support Families for Safe Streets to attend the 2018 Vision Zero conference including providing \$3,000 for travel expenses.
- Ensure that staff performing service under this contract will be able to:
 - Pass criminal background checks required for school districts served
 - If driving for the purpose of fulfilling this contract, possess a valid State of Oregon driver's license and
 - If driving, pass the city of Portland Defensive Driver's Training
