We the undersigned, deputy auditors of the City of Portland, in the License Department, do hereby certify that on this date we personally called on:

Mee Fong Company, 91 Second Street;  
On Hing Company, 66 Second Street;  
Quong Shong Tong We Kee Company, 185 Second Street;  
Wing Chong Company, 104 $\frac{1}{2}$  Second Street.

and in pursuance of Ordinance No. 15907 entitled "An Ordinance revoking certain liquor licenses" we tendered to each of the said persons the sum of Forty-one and eighty-five/100 dollars (\$41.85) to cover the unexpired portion of said liquor licenses, which sum of money each refused to accept, but all of the said parties closed their several saloons with the exception of On Hing Company at 66 Second Street, who refused to accept the tender of money and also refused to close his saloon, whereupon, we placed him under arrest and took him to the Police Station, and filed a complaint against him, and since that time his place has been closed.
