Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The State of Oregon, Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM) has notified the City that it will award a subgrant for the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant Program to the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management in the amount of \$4,955.
