Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The State of Oregon, Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management (OEM) has notified the City that it will award a subgrant for the 2018 State Homeland Security Grant Program to the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management in the amount of \$4,955. This legislation authorizes the Mayor to accept the grant on behalf of the City. The grant period is October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

OEM will reimburse the City for program expenses not to exceed \$4,955 for a low-tech system for tracking disaster response personnel. No match requirement for this grant.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The general community will not be directly impacted, but the project will provide improved tracking of personnel responding to emergencies. No community involvement planned.
