

ORDINANCE No. 189384

* Pay bodily injury claim of Sunjay Kumar in the sum of \$12,716 resulting from a vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Sunjay Kumar, through attorney George G. Curtis, has filed a bodily injury claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Police Bureau on October 18, 2017.
2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$12,716.66 subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

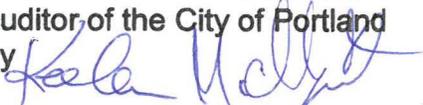
NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver two checks in following amounts:
 - i) one in the amount of \$7,500 made payable to Zbinden and Curtis Trust Account, and
 - ii) one in the amount of \$5,216.66 made payable to American Family Mutual Insurance Company S.I.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute payment authorizations in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this bodily injury claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
