Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

As part of the classification and compensation system implemented December 13, 2018, the Bureau of Human Resources intended to assign the classification of Occupational Health Specialist to salary grade 59. However, due to a scrivener's error in the ordinance creating the structure this classification was mistakenly assigned to salary grade 58. This legislation corrects that error.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The maximum annual salary for salary grade 58 is \$126,318. The maximum annual salary for salary grade 59 is \$140,338 for a difference of \$14,020.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This action is largely internal to City government processes.
