Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- Natural disasters can happen anytime, and the transportation system needs to be prepared to provide needed transport for fuel, essential supplies and medical transport, during and after any emergency. The Regional Disaster Preparedness Organization (RDPO) and Metro will be updating the existing ETRs and MOU agreement for the 5-county Portland-Vancouver metropolitan region; and
- This IGA will allow the research of (1) best practices in emergency transportation route management, and (2) the policy framework in which the ETRs currently operate in the Portland-Vancouver metropolitan region. This project provides foundational knowledge for the implementation of the Regional ETR update project led by RDPO and Metro

• This IGA will be 100% grant funded through the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) 18 federal grant.
