

ORDINANCE No. 189490

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the South Portland - Burlingame Phase 1 Sewer Rehabilitation Project No.E10680, for an estimated cost of \$2,112,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate 3,700-ft of sanitary and combined sewer pipe primarily in the South Portland and Burlingame areas that is in severely deteriorated condition.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including manholes and service laterals.
3. The established cost is \$2,112,000. The level of confidence in the estimate is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 19-20 and FY 20-21 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10680.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$2,112,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
