Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- The purpose of this legislation is to establish City Council support and authorization to submit a grant application to the Oregon Department of Transportation and Department of Land Conservation and Development through the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) Grant Program. The Portland Bureau of Transportation will submit one grant application for the Lower SE Portland Area Plan, an integrated land use and transportation plan for an area of SE Portland including portions of Brentwood-Darlington, Mt. Scott-Arleta, Lents, and Woodstock neighborhoods.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

- If the grant is funded, the total estimated cost to complete this plan is \$250,000. The TGM Grant program will pay up to an estimated \$220,000. Local match in the amount of \$30,000 will be provided by staff time funded by General Transportation Revenue in PBOT's FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22 budgets.
