

ORDINANCE No. 189546

*Amend Ordinance to authorize contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide payment for construction of the Luther Road Restoration Project No. E10854 in the amount of \$1,827,000 (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 189430)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On March 20, 2019, the Council passed Ordinance No. 189430 to authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsive bidder and provide payment for the construction of the Luther Road Restoration Project No. E10854 in the amount of \$1,750,000
2. On April 23, 2019 bids were received and the lowest responsive and responsible bidder is Keystone Contracting, Inc. with a bid amount of \$1,827,000.
3. Additional authorization is needed to enter into a contract at the established cost of \$1,827,000. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2019-20 Capital Improvement Program, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10854.C60.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Keystone Contracting, Inc. in the amount of \$1,827,000 provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would cause the project to miss the regulatory in-water construction window, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
