**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

As the city of Portland densifies, access and service delivery must become more responsive to serve all Portlanders. Mobile service delivery, and increased access, are essential to this future. Current community centers lack adequate infrastructure for community gathering spaces, including but not limited to acoustical and lighting quality, presentation platforms, and related support such as electricity and restrooms. Arts capacity projects will serve multiple users with an arts focus. Investments will be evaluated on geographic distribution, with service-gap analysis of the surrounding community.
