## ORDINANCE No. 189753

\* Authorize applications to Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development for a technical assistance grant and Business Oregon for a planning grant in the total amount of \$60,000 for marine industrial land analysis (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland City Council shares the goals of the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) and Business Oregon for sound economic development analysis and planning.
- 2. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability (BPS) is preparing a 2020 update of Portland's Economic Opportunities Analysis (EOA) to assess employment land needs to 2040. BPS seeks grant funding of \$60,000 for a consultant contract to analyze marine terminal and marine industrial land demand as an early phase of the EOA Update. BPS staff has coordinated with the Port of Portland which will manage and fund a marine cargo forecast to inform the land demand analysis.
- 3. BPS staff have reviewed the grant programs, coordinated with other agencies, and obtained letters of support for the grant proposals.
- 4. BPS submitted an application on October 1, 2019, to DLCD for a Technical Assistance Grant of \$60,000 for Marine Industrial Land Analysis. No local match will be provided.
- 5. BPS submitted an intake form in October 2019 to Business Oregon for a Planning Grant of up to \$60,000 for Marine Industrial Land Analysis, in case a DLCD grant does not fully fund the project. No local match will be provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make applications to Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) and Business Oregon for the above referenced grants in the total amount of \$60,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because authorization of the grant application must be submitted no later than DLCD's issuance of grant awards in

December 2019; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
