ORDINANCE NO. 149053

An Ordinance amending Title 3, Administration of the Code of the City of Portland, by adding a new chapter, 3.114, Office of Cable Communications, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City presently has in effect franchises for the operation of cable communications systems in certain areas of the City.
- 2. The City is in the process of developing and issuing a Request for Proposals for a cable communications franchise for the entire City, subject to certain limitations.
- 3. The City presently has a Fire Bureau Cable Communications System.
- 4. It is necessary and desirable that the City have an Office of Cable Communications with responsibility for supervising the cable communications franchising process, monitoring performance by cable communications franchisees, promoting orderly development of the existing Fire Bureau Cable Communications System for Fire Bureau and other Public Safety purposes, and performing other work related to cable communications in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Title 3, Administration, of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to add a new Chapter, 3.114, as follows:

Chapter 3.114

OFFICE OF CABLE COMMUNICATIONS

Sections:

- 3.110.010 Creation and Functions
- 3.110.020 Jurisdiction

ORDINANCE No.

3.110.010 Creation and Functions. There is hereby established an Office of Cable Communications. Office shall be administered by a Director and shall have such other employees as the Council may provide. The Office shall be responsible for supervising all cable communications franchising processes engaged in by the City, for monitoring performance by cable communications franchisees, for promoting orderly development of City-owned cable communications systems, and for performing all other necessary work related to cable communications in the City.

3.110.020 Jurisdiction. The Office shall have jurisdiction over all cable communications matters affecting the City of Portland.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because there is a present need for the cable communications functions described herein to be performed immediately; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
