

To the Honorable the Mayor and Common Council of the City
of Portland:--

Gentlemen:--

The undersigned Chinese residents and merchants of the
City of Portland would respectfully represent and show to
your Honorable body;

That heretofore there has been no hospital or means es-
tablished by the Chinese of this City for caring for their
countrymen when sick or suffering from disease or injury, but
that recently the Chinese have rented rooms on the East Side
of Second Street between Stark and Oak Streets in this City
and propose fitting the same up as a hospital for their sick
and disabled countrymen while sojourning in Portland and to
provide them with proper treatment and means of attention.

That in order to designate the same as a public place to
render the same easily found it is the desire of your peti-
tioners to erect ^{and against the wall} in front of said building a flag pole extend-
ing from the second store thereof fifty feet in height which
shall be thoroughly fastened to the walls of the building ~~put~~
up in the most substantial manner, upon which flag pole they
desire to suspend thereon a flag having the initials letters
of the hospital thereon, viz: B.L.K.S. the name of the said
Hospital being the Bo Long Kong Sue Company.

Wherefore your petitioners pray your Honorable body to
grant to said Bo Long Kong Sue Company permission to erect and
maintain said flag pole and to suspend said flag therefrom and
as in duty bound your petitioners will ever pray.
