Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

By approving this report, Council confirms the Mayor's appointment of two new members and an alternate member to the Portland Committee on Community Engaged Policing (PCCEP). The mission of the PCCEP is to work with the Mayor/Police Commissioner, Portland Police Bureau, and Portland's diverse constituencies to solicit and exchange information between the community and Portland Police Bureau (PPB) to achieve the desired outcomes of equitable policing which exceeds constitutional requirements, and meaningful community engagement with and trust in PPB.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The selection process for PCCEP members begins with the submission of an application. After applicants are screened, members of community-based organizations are invited to be members of the interview panel for the applicants. The community members are encouraged to ask the applicant questions they may have that are specific to the people that they consider their own community as well as questions they feel are pertinent to the broader context of the Portland community. After the interview, each panel member is invited to share any questions or concerns they may have about the applicant as well as perceived strengths. They are then asked whether or not they would support moving forward with a candidate. That process was followed here.
