ORDINANCE NO. 118167

An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of Lots 4, 5, and 6, Block 8, Portland Highlands at S. W 15th Avenue and Marigold Street from Jack L. David and Ruth L. David for the sum of \$4,700 plus the pro rata share of the 1963-64 real property taxes, for a storage tank site for the Bureau of Water Works, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

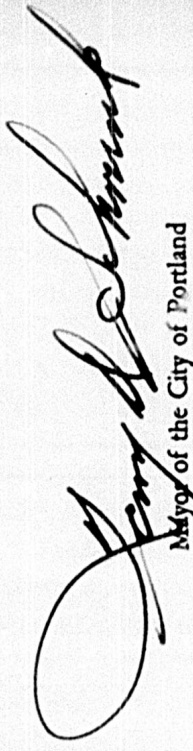
Section 1. The Council finds that it is necessary to purchase Lots 4, 5, and 6, Block 8, Portland Highlands at S. W. 15th Avenue and Marigold Street for a storage tank site for the Bureau of Water Works; that said property is presently owned by Jack L. David and Ruth L. David, husband and wife, who have agreed to sell said property to the City of Portland for the sum of \$4,700 plus the pro rata share of the 1963-64 real property taxes; now, therefore, the purchase of Lots 4, 5 and 6, Block 8, Portland Highlands, in the County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, from Jack L. David and Ruth L. David, husband and wife, hereby is authorized, and the Mayor and Auditor hereby are authorized and directed to draw and deliver the following warrants in payment therefor, which shall be charged to the Water Construction Fund, Appropriation Land (5900.780):

1. Warrant in the amount of \$45.00 payable to the Title and Trust Company, 321 S. W. 4th Avenue, Portland, Oregon, 97204, for a preliminary title report and title policy in the amount of the purchase price;
2. Warrant in the amount of \$5.50 payable to the United States Postmaster for revenue stamps to be affixed to the deed to the City;
3. Warrant in the amount of \$4,653.82 payable to Jack L. David and Ruth L. David, husband and wife, to be delivered upon receipt of a good and sufficient warranty deed approved as to form by the City Attorney, for recording by the City Auditor. Said warrants represents the purchase price plus the City's pro rata share of the 1963-64 real property taxes less the cost of title insurance, the cost of revenue stamps and \$10.00 previously paid as option money.

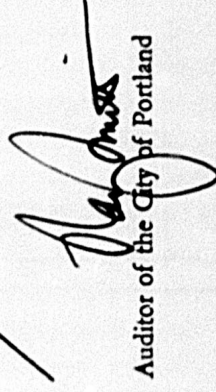
ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: in order that purchase of the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance may be authorized without unnecessary delay, therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
