ORDINANCE No. 189946

* Pay bodily injury claim of Mary Livesay in the sum of \$49,900 resulting from a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Mary Livesay, through attorney Brendan Burke and insurer Geico, has filed a bodily injury claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle collision involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation on March 12, 2018.
- 2 The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$49,900, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a. a check in the amount of \$42,000 made payable to Clark Law and Associates for Mary Livesay.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$7,900 made payable to Geico.
- Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in C. the amount set forth in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) above.

Section 2 The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
