

ORDINANCE No. 91125

An Ordinance abolishing one position of Medium Equipment Operator and creating one position of Heavy Equipment Operator in the Bureau of Refuse Disposal; fixing the salary; providing for the drawing of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Council finds that the retirement of a medium equipment operator in the Bureau of Refuse Disposal has created a vacancy in said Bureau; the Council further finds that the operation of a recently acquired power shovel requires a Heavy Equipment Operator under Civil Service classification; now, therefore, the position of Medium Equipment Operator in the Bureau of Refuse Disposal, at \$280.00 per month is hereby abolished, and there is created one position of Heavy Equipment Operator at a salary of \$280.00 per month.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants in payment of said salary on the regular payroll at the same time and in the same manner as other payroll warrants are drawn and made chargeable to 2400.110.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: The position herein created is needed without delay; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
