

ORDINANCE No. 92012

An Ordinance designating and assigning certain property owned by the City of Portland Assessment Collection Fund to the public for street purposes for the widening of N.E. 19th Avenue and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that the parcel of land herein described constitutes certain portions of Blocks 1 and 2, Irvington Park, owned by the City of Portland in fee simple for the benefit of the Assessment Collection Division, which property has been sold under contracts to various purchasers with the condition that said property would be dedicated for street purposes; that the parcel of land herein described is required for the widening and improvement of N.E. 19th Avenue and that such will contribute to the public convenience by providing better street access; now, therefore, the following portions of Blocks 1 and 2, Irvington Park, in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, are hereby designated and assigned to the use aforesaid:

Beginning at the intersection of the south line of N.E. Holman Street and the east line of N.E. 19th Avenue; thence east along the south line of N.E. Holman Street to a point 48.0 feet east of the west line of N.E. 19th Avenue; thence south parallel to the west line of N.E. 19th Avenue to a point on the south line of Lot 6, Block 2, Irvington Park; thence west along the south line of said Lot 6 to a point on the east line of N.E. 19th Avenue; thence north tracing the east line of N.E. 19th Avenue to the place of beginning, being a strip of land for the widening of N.E. 19th Avenue.

Section 2. That the Auditor be and he hereby is directed to have a certified copy of this ordinance placed on record and a copy of said ordinance forwarded to the County Assessor.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health,

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peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: That the widening of said street should be made a matter of record at the earliest possible date to avoid any undue delay in the improvement of said street; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
