An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 96656 passed by the Council July 3, 1952, entitled: "An Ordinance providing for the clearing of title of portions of certain streets acquired by the City, authorizing the drawing of warrant, and declaring an emergency", to correct an error in the description of certain real property therein, and declaring an emergency.

## The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. It appearing to the Council that an error was made in Ordinance No. 96656, passed by the Council July 3, 1952, in setting out the description of the third described parcel in Section 1 of said Ordinance No. 96656; that said Ordinance should be amended to properly describe the said parcel intended to be acquired; now, therefore, Ordinance No. 96656 passed by the Council July 3, 1952, entitled "An Ordinance providing for the clearing of title of portions of certain streets acquired by the City, authorizing the drawing of warrant, and declaring an emergency" hereby is amended by changing the description of the real property in Section 1 of said Ordinance to read as follows:

A strip of land beginning at the intersection of the north line of N.E. Ainsworth Street and the westerly line of N.E. 21st Avenue, as laid out and established in Irvington Park; thence northerly along said westerly line a distance of 170.68 feet; thence westerly parallel to the northerly line of N.E. Ainsworth Street a distance of 41.38 feet, more or less, to a point 50.0 feet west of the west line of Block 6, Irvington Park; thence southerly parallel with the west line of said Block 6, to a point on the northerly line of N.E. Ainsworth Street, 40.9 feet, more or less, westerly of the place of beginning; thence easterly to the place of beginning, containing an area of 7,022 square feet, more or less.

Beginning at a point on the northwesterly line of Block 15, Woodlawn, 36 feet west of the west line of Lot 1, Block 5, Lowell, when measured at right angles to said west line; thence south, parallel to said west line, to a point on the southwesterly line of Block 15, Woodlawn; thence southeasterly to the most southerly corner of said Block 15; thence southerly, along the east line of Woodlawn, to a point 100 feet south of the north line of Woodlawn; thence east, slong the north line of Lot A, Block 5, Lowell, to a point on the southerly extension of the west line of Lot 1, Block 5, Lowell; thence north, along said southerly extension and the west line of Lot 1, Block 5, Lowell,

to the easterly extension of the north line of Woodlawn; thence west, along said easterly extension and the north line of Woodlawn, to the southeasterly line of Woodlawn Avenue; thence southwesterly to the place of beginning, containing 3309 square feet. more or less.

Beginning at the northeast corner of Block 39, Woodlawn; thence north along the north projection of the east line of said Block 39, 33.66 feet to the south line of the Lewis Love D.L.C.; thence west along said Lewis Love D.L.C. 200 feet to the north projection of the west line of said Block 39; thence south along said projection to the northwest corner of said Block 39; thence east along the north line of said Block 39; to the place of beginning, containing 6,946 square feet, more or less.

The east 30 feet of the north 90 feet of Block 3. Town of Wayne, in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah and State of Oregon.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that no unnecessary delay may be occasioned in the closing of this transaction, this ordinance should be made immediately effective; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
