## ORDINANCE No. 124455

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to Dr. and Mrs. Robert Sproed, 7825 S.E. 114th Avenue, to keep two goats on their premises, subject to certain conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. The Council finds that Dr. and Mrs. Robert Sproed, 7825 S. E. 114th Avenue, have petitioned for a permit to keep two goats on their premises; that with said petition was filed the written consents of all the residents within 200 feet of the property where the two goats are to be maintained, with the exception of one property owner whose property adjoins the petitioners' property; that the Bureau of Nuisance Abatement and the Health Bureau have submitted reports wherein no objections were found to granting of petitioners' request; now, therefore, a revocable permit hereby is granted to Dr. and Mrs. Robert Sproed, 7825 S.E. 114th Avenue, to keep two goats on their premises; provided, however, that all health and sanitation requirements of the City of Portland shall be strictly complied with.

Section 2. It is expressly understood that nothing herein contained and no expenditure of money, lapse of time or any other thing shall be deemed to grant any vested right under the terms of this ordinance; that the permit herein granted shall be revocable at any time at the option of the Council with or without notice. This ordinance shall be of no force or effect until the permittee has filed with the City Auditor a written acceptance of the terms hereof, in a form approved by the City Attorney.


Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that there may be no unnecessary delay in granting the permit hereinabove provided for; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
