ORDINANCE No. 190172

Update Loss Control and Prevention Code to streamline coordination and implementation of citywide loss prevention activities and remove the Loss Control and Prevention Advisory Committee (Ordinance; replace Code Chapter 3.54)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Employee safety, controlling and reducing the number of employee injuries and costs associated with workers' compensation claims, and meeting regulatory compliance are priorities of the City.
- 2. Risk Management is tasked with effectively and efficiently coordinating Citywide loss prevention activities and programs. The proposed amendments to Chapter 3.54 streamline procedures, add clarity, and align with best practices.
- 3. The Loss Control and Prevention Advisory Committee, which was an internal committee, has not been active for at least 10 years. The responsibility and authority of the Committee overlap with the responsibility and authority of Risk Management, as proposed.
- 4. Risk Management collaborated with City bureaus and offices to make improvements to Chapter 3.54 that streamline loss prevention activities for compliance with Oregon Occupational Safety and Health (OR OSHA) Self-Insured requirements, outlined in Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 437-001-1060 Self-Insured and Group Self-Insured Employer Loss Prevention Effort, as shown in Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a) Replace Portland City Code Chapter 3.54, as shown in Exhibit B.
