**Brief Description of the Topic:**

The Oregon Cannabis Association, is in full support of CPOT's request for Emergency Relief Funds for Portland's cannabis businesses suffering from uninsurable loss and financially devastating damages due largely to increased targeted criminal activity during the last 4 months and the recent Oregon wildfires. Ultimately, without viable cannabis businesses, the City's Adult-Use Cannabis Tax Fund will not continue to grow at its average rate of 36%, providing much-needed resources to community grants for education and economic development. On October 12, 2020, CPOT submitted a letter to all Council offices outlining three critical requests that will help support the continued growth of the city's cannabis industry and long-term sustainability.
