ORDINANCE 148985

An Ordinance granting a Revocable Permit to Russell E. and Marilyn A. Waddle, deedholders, dba Waddle's Restaurant/Waddle's Drive-In Coffee Shop, to construct a fence within a special setback area, in zone C2; located at N.E. 82nd Avenue, south of N.E. Klickitat Street, on Lots 1-18, Block 11, Gregory Heights, under certain conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Russell E. and Marilyn A. Waddle, deedholders, dba Waddle's Restaurant/Waddle's Drive-In Coffee Shop, have filed application for a Revocable Permit to construct a fence within a special setback area, in zone C2; located at N.E. 82nd Avenue, south of N.E. Klickitat Street.
- The legal description of said property is Lots 1-18, Block 11, Gregory Heights.
- 3. Applicants have paid the proper fee for the filing of such an application.
- 4. A duly authorized and conducted public hearing has been held by the City's Hearings Officer on December 10, 1979 (Planning Commission File No. 6904R) and the Hearings Officer recommends that a Revocable Permit in order to construct a fence within a special setback area be allowed, under certain conditions.
- 5. The City Auditor has complied with the notice requirements of the ordinance for the hearing before the Hearings Officer.
- 6. The City Council after due deliberation in open session adopted the report of the Hearings Officer.
- 7. Granting the Revocable Permit to allow the fence at this location is in the public interest and not detrimental or injurious to the public health, safety or welfare and will enhance the attractiveness of 82nd Avenue in this area and would not impair the possibility of future further improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That a Revocable Permit be granted to allow construction of a 30 inch high fence within the special setback area along 82nd Avenue; located at N.E. 82nd Avenue, south of N.E. Klickitat Street, on Lots 1-18, Block 11, Gregory Heights.

- b. This Revocable Permit is granted under the following conditions:
 - 1. The fence posts shall be no more than approximately 30 inches high.
 - A Building Permit or an Occupancy Permit must be obtained from the Bureau of Buildings, Room 111, City Hall, 1220 S.W. Fifth Avenue, 248-4241, before carrying out this project in order to assure that all conditions imposed here and all requirements of the pertinent Building Codes are met.
 - 3. The Revocable Permit hereby granted is personal to the permittee and may not be transferred, assigned or otherwise disposed of by said permittee.
 - 4. The Revocable Permit hereby granted shall be revocable at the pleasure of the City Council and no expenditures of money hereunder or lapse of time or any act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland, or be held to give the permittees any vested or other right.
 - 5. Permittee shall comply with the provisions of the Code of the City of Portland, and all other applicable ordinances, provisions and regulations of the City, whether presently existing or hereafter enacted.
- C. Neither this ordinance nor any permit issued hereunder shall be effective until accepted, filed and recorded in accordance with law.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because there should be no delay in the beneficial use of the above-described property; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
