

ORDINANCE No. 148993

An Ordinance authorizing the Bureau of Maintenance to construct and maintain a vehicle fuel island with a canopy and a fuel tank in the east side of N. Borthwick Avenue south of N. Stanton Street, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Maintenance has been authorized to close and use N. Borthwick Avenue from the south line of N. Stanton Street to the north line of N. Graham Street and N. Stanton Street from the east line of N. Mississippi Avenue to the west line of N. Kerby Avenue, along with other streets, by Ordinance No. 146495 passed by the Council September 20, 1978.
- 2. The Bureau of Maintenance has submitted plans for the construction of the Stanton Yard Refueling Facility and that a portion of said facility will extend into the right of way of N. Borthwick Avenue.
- 3. Granting of the desired permission, under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Bureau of Maintenance is authorized to construct the Stanton Yard Refueling Facility on the east side of N. Borthwick Avenue south of N. Stanton Street, as shown on the plan marked "Exhibit A", attached to and by this reference made a part of this Ordinance, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) This authority is only for so long as the City is leasing the adjacent property from the State of Oregon.
 - (2) This authority is for the stipulated purpose only and shall not exempt the Bureau of Maintenance from obtaining any required license, permit or approval

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay will result in an unnecessary hardship; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
