

ORDINANCE NO. **149052**

An Ordinance amending Section 20.20.010 of the City Code to revise rates charged at municipal golf courses, eliminating reference to Hoyt Pitch-n-Putt Golf Course, establishing an effective date of February 1, 1980, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Golf Fund is an enterprise fund managed by the Bureau of Parks, which must be self-sufficient and generate sufficient revenues to cover all operating expenses and to provide for replacement and improvement of its physical assets on a planned basis.
2. A five-year projection of revenue and expenditures, prepared by the Bureau of Parks, indicates the need for periodic fee increases to maintain said self-sustaining condition.
3. In line with this projection, the Commissioner in charge recommends the following rate changes to be effective February 1, 1980, to cover anticipated operating expenses and capital outlay requirements.
4. Section 20.20.010(h) relating to fees for use of Hoyt Pitch-n-Putt Golf Course should be eliminated due to closure of the course.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

1. Section 20.20.010 of the City Code is amended to read as follows:

20.20.010 Playing rates. (a) The following rates shall be charged and collected for the privilege of playing golf on the Eastmoreland, Rose City, Progress Downs, and West Delta Golf Courses:

For a 9-hole ticket on weekdays	<u>\$3.00</u>
For a 9-hole ticket on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays	<u>\$4.00</u>
For an 18-hole ticket on weekdays	<u>\$6.00</u>
For an 18-hole ticket on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays	<u>\$7.50</u>

(Holiday rates shall be charged on these days:

New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. In the event the holiday falls on a weekend, these rates will apply only on the day the holiday actually falls and not on the Friday preceding nor the Monday following.)

- (d) For senior citizens 65 years or older, who are permanent residents of the City of Portland, with proper proof of age and residency, the rate for 9 holes or less shall be one-half the rate of a regular 9-hole weekday ticket, rounded to the nearest five cent increment, (\$1.50).

OR

A special 6-month ticket may be purchased for the period October 1 through March 31, and the cost of said ticket shall be \$75.00.

For senior citizens 65 years or older who are not permanent residents of the City of Portland, with proper proof of age, the rate for 9 holes or less shall be \$.50 more than the rate for resident seniors.

The senior citizen rates will not be valid on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays before 3:00 p.m. or after 4:00 p.m. on weekdays between April 1 and September 30.

Any City resident 85 years or older may play without fee on weekdays at hours for senior play.


Section 2. The fee revision authorized by this ordinance shall be effective February 1, 1980.


Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in effectiveness of the revised golf rates as outlined in Section 1 hereof will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of the increased fees; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
