ORDINANCE No. 149179

An Ordinance transferring identified appropriation savings through the Second Quarter of 1979-80 within funds; transferring funds within certain operating bureau budgets and between funds, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On February 15, 1980, the City Council received the Second Quarterly Allotment Report for FY 1979-80 in which actual expenditures have been compared to planned expenditures on projects, activities, and programs, and unneeded appropriations have been identified in several City agencies;
- 2. Through the end of the Second Quarter (December 19, 1979) various City agencies identified \$792,368 of appropriations which will not be needed to conduct the planned level of City activity for the remainder of FY 1979-80;
- 3. Several bureaus require that funds be transferred between line items and major object codes within their budgets;
- 4. The Bureau of Management and Budget has prepared this ordinance transferring appropriations consistent with the Allotment Report and as indicated in the attached Exhibits A and B.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs that appropriations be transferred in accordance with the Exhibits A and B, attached;

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary that appropriation adjustments herein described be entered into FMS as soon as possible in order that appropriations reflect Council policy; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
