

## ORDINANCE No. 149191

An Ordinance authorizing an application to the Economic Development Administration for a grant-in-aid estimated at \$1,282,450 for constructing the Rivergate Interceptor, authorizing a contract, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. EDA makes grants-in-aid to local governments for public works activities which support the retention and expansion of employment.
2. The Bureau of Sanitary Engineering provides for wastewater facilities and could further the City's effort therein by a grant-in-aid of said services.
3. The project cost is estimated at \$2,564,900 of which \$1,282,450 is required as local share, of which the Port of Portland will provide \$641,225 and the balance of \$641,225 from the Sewage Disposal Fund.
4. Should the City receive the grant, it will be obligated to comply with the regulations of EDA.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Commissioner in charge shall make application to EDA for a grant-in-aid of \$1,282,450 for constructing the Rivergate Interceptor.
- b. Should the described grant be approved, a contract or grant agreement is authorized.
- c. The City Engineer is hereby designated as the City of Portland's authorized representative for all administrative matters in relation to the said grant application and subsequent agreement.
- d. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide assurances regarding the use of the grant as may be required by EDA.
- e. The Commissioner in charge is authorized to provide for receipt, expenditure, and accounting for the grant project.

## ORDINANCE No.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because regulations governing the grant application require immediate application, and delay in application may result in the loss of opportunity to receive the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.




