ORDINANCE NO. **149207**

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to Holy Cross Parish to place banners across N. Lombard Street between N. Hodge Avenue and N. Hereford Avenue for a Church Bazaar on March 9, 1980 and a Church Auction on May 3, 1980, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Archdiocese of Portland, Oregon for Holy Cross Parish has, through James Kuffner, 7040 N. Chase Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97217, requested permission to place a banner across N. Lombard Street between N. Hodge Avenue and N. Hereford Avenue from February 29, 1980 through March 10, 1980; and again from April 25, 1980 through May 5, 1980.
2. That said banners are for the purpose of promoting two fund-raising events for the Holy Cross Parish; one to be held on March 9, and the other to be held on May 3.
3. The granting of said permissions, under certain conditions, will not be detrimental to the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. A revocable permit is hereby granted to Holy Cross Parish, grantee, to place a banner across N. Lombard Street between N. Hodge Avenue and N. Hereford Avenue from February 29, 1980 through March 10, 1980; and again from April 25, 1980 through May 5, 1980, subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) All banners must have a clearance of 18 feet above the roadway of the street and 10 feet above the sidewalk and comply with State Highway regulations governing such installations.
 - (2) Approval for use of utility poles and manner of securing and fastening overhead cables to the poles must be obtained from the utility companies involved.
 - (3) This permit is for the use of the street area only and shall not exempt the grantee from obtaining any license or permit required by City Code or Ordinance for any act to be performed under this permit, nor shall this permit waive the provision of any City Code or Ordinance or the City Charter except as herein stated.


- (4) This permit is revocable at any time at the pleasure of the Council and no expenditure of money or lapse of time or other act or thing shall operate as an estoppel against the City of Portland or to be held to give the grantee any vested or other right.
- (5) The grantee shall hold the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees free and harmless from any claims for damages to persons or property, including legal fees and costs of defending any actions or suits, including any appeals which may result from the use of the street area under this permit by providing evidence of insurance protecting the City of Portland, its officers, agents, and employees as follows:
 Bodily injury \$100,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, property damage \$50,000 for one claimant and \$300,000 for one occurrence, said insurance to be kept in full force and effect at all times. This permit is automatically revoked without further action by the Council if this insurance is permitted to lapse, is cancelled or, for any other reason, becomes inoperative.

Section 2. This Ordinance will not become effective until the grantee has filed with the City Auditor both a document accepting the terms and conditions hereof, and the evidence of insurance, each of which has been approved by the City Attorney.


Section 3. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the enactment of this Ordinance will result in an unnecessary hardship of uncertainty on the part of the applicant as to the status of the requested permit for the hanging of the banner; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage.
