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ORDINANCE NO. 149276

An Ordinance amending Contract No. 18333 with Project Return, Inc. under CETA Title II-B with the Human Resources Bureau, Training and Employment Division; increasing the contract amount; adding an additional position; transferring appropriations in the amount of \$3,500 within the CETA Fund; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 148695, the City of Portland authorized Contract No. 18333 with Project Return, Inc. to provide services to Portland veterans under the Human Resources Bureau, Training and Employment Division (TED).
- 2. It has been determined that this contract requires an additional position of Paralegal Specialist to better serve CETA clients.
- 3. An agreement has been reached with the Multnomah-Washington County CETA Consortium to pay one-half of the position salary, with TED assuming the remainder.
- 4. Sufficient funds are budgeted and available under CETA, Title II-B to cover the cost of this amendment.
- 5. It is therefore appropriate that the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities execute, on behalf of the City, an amendment to Contract No. 18333, as set forth in Exhibit "A".
