ORDINANCE No. 190226

Amend the Portland Parks and Recreation Board to clarify purpose, definitions, membership and update administrative functions (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 3.27)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance No. 176002, passed by the Council and became effective on October 10, 2001, authorized establishment of a Parks and Recreation Board and created a new City Code Chapter 3.27.
- 2. Since it was created, Section 3.27.030 was updated, in Ordinance No. 184647, effective June 8, 2011.
- 3. On November 8, 2017, Resolution No. 37328, passed by the Council to enhance community service opportunities, strengthen the transparency and accountability of City advisory bodies, and gave the Office of Community and Civic Life the directive to create a bylaws template for advisory bodies.
- 4. On October 13, 2020, the Parks and Recreation Board voted to recommend updates to their bylaws and City Code Chapter 3.27 that would bring their guiding documents in alignment with the template provided by the Office of Community and Civic Life, clarify their purpose, definitions, and membership, and update some administrative functions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

Amend Portland City Code Chapter 3.27 as shown in Exhibit A. a.
