A communication to voters related to a City of Portland candidate election failed to prominently disclose information as required by City Code Section 2.10.030.

Complainants are encouraged to submit all documentation or evidence relevant to the alleged violation with the complaint.

This is the same violation that was levied upon Mayor Wheeler. The City Elections Office fined Ted Wheeler's campaign \$2,000 this week. The campaign failed to include required disclosures about contributors in a May 14 email as reported by Willamette Week reporter Nige Jaquiss
