



Open and Accountable Elections Complaint Form

Any individual or organization may file a written complaint about a violation of Office of Open and Accountable Elections law, rules, or guidance. Complaints must be made in writing and signed. Anonymous complaints may not be investigated.

Complaints must be filed by:

- More than 42 days out from a primary/general: Within 30 days of the alleged violation.
- 0-42 days before the primary/general: Within 7 days of the alleged violation.
