ORDINANCE NO. 149336

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 148921, which authorized five Public Service Employment contracts under CETA Title IID; changing the funding source from Title IID to Title VI Special Projects; amending the contracts to reflect this funding change; transferring funds in the amount of \$194,482 within the CETA Fund; and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 148921, the City of Portland entered into five Public Service Employment contracts under CETA Title IID.
2. The contracts are Nos. 18522, 18476, 18466, 18489, and 18501, and run from January 1, 1980 to September 30, 1980.
3. It has been determined that these contracts should more properly be funded under Title VI as Special Projects, as defined by the Department of Labor CETA Regulations.
4. It is therefore appropriate that the five contracts authorized by Ordinance No. 148921 be funded under CETA Title VI Special Projects instead of Title IID.
5. It is further appropriate that the Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Utilities execute, on behalf of the City, an amendment to Contracts Nos. 18466, 18476, 18489, 18501, and 18522, changing the contract funding to Title VI of CETA as set forth in the Exhibits hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and Commissioner of Public Utilities execute, on behalf of the City, an amendment to five contracts, numbered 18466, 18476, 18489, 18501, and 18522, changing the contract funding to Title VI of CETA, as set forth in the Exhibits hereto.
