

ORDINANCE No. 149395

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 149056, being an ordinance assessing upon certain property the cost of repairing and constructing sidewalks, curbs and driveways in front thereof for the one-month billing period ended October 31, 1979, by cancelling the assessment for Tax Lot '1' of Lots 4 and 5, Block 8, Fulton, and reducing the total assessment by \$476.63, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Ordinance No. 149056 assessed Tax Lot '1' of Lots 4 and 5, Block 8, Fulton, \$476.63 for the repair and construction of sidewalks, curbs and driveways in front thereof for the one-month billing period ended October 31, 1979, and entered in City Lien Docket Book 124, Page 138.
2. This charge was paid by interagency transfer of funds and should not be included in the assessment.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Ordinance No. 149056 is amended by cancelling the assessment against Tax Lot '1' of Lots 4 and 5, Block 8, Fulton, by \$476.63 and reducing the total assessment of \$33,272.77 to \$32,796.14.


