

ORDINANCE No. 149453

An Ordinance authorizing the Purchasing Agent to advertise and receive proposals for furnishing a 1,000 gallon Fire truck to the Bureau of Fleet Management for assignment to the Water Bureau, authorizing a contract to the lowest acceptable bidder, authorizing the drawing and delivery of warrants, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Fleet Management requires a 1,000 gallon Fire truck for assignment to the Water Bureau to be used in the Bull Run Reservoir.
2. The estimated cost of this vehicle is \$50,000. Funds are available in the Bureau's FY 79-80 Approved Budget for this purchase.
3. The Bureau of Fleet Management recommends and the Commissioner of Public Utilities concurs that the Purchasing Agent should advertise and receive bids for this unit according to the Specifications delivered to the Purchasing Agent on March 17, 1980; and that a contract should be executed, and warrants be issued, for purchase of this vehicle.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent shall advertise for bids using individual specifications filed in his office for the above item on March 17, 1980, and in the event that no satisfactory bids are received, shall readvertise on the same specifications until satisfactory bids are received.
- b. Contracts are authorized with the most favorable bidders as designated by the Council.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the 1979-1980 Budget, Fleet Operating Fund, Bureau of Fleet Management, BUC No. 56200037, Object 643 Equipment, Motor Vehicles, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.



The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase may result in additional expenses, and will unnecessarily deprive the City of the benefits of completion of the contract at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
