

AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made this _____ day of _____, 1980, by and between Level One, Inc., and the CITY OF PORTLAND, Bureau of Computer Services (hereinafter BOCS);

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, Level One, Inc., and BOCS are parties to that certain agreement dated August 20, 1979, providing for services, City Contract No. 18115 and desire to amend said agreement as hereinafter setforth;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1.) In accordance with Paragraph 1.B of said agreement of August 20, 1979, which provides for requested and preventative maintenance the parties hereby amend Paragraph 1.B. by adding to the end of the sentence "Maintenance includes the effort required to reinitialize the MDT System software" the following words: "and to provide programming to allow the maximum number of MDT units." The rate schedule in Paragraph 1.B. is also amended to increase the maximum for Labor from \$7,200 to \$14,000.
- 2.) In accordance with Paragraph 2 of said agreement of August 20, 1979, which provides that "Cost to the City will not exceed the following," the parties hereby amend Paragraph 2 by deleting the amounts "11,800.00" and "\$55,880.00", shown in said paragraph as the amount for maintenance through June 30, 1980 and TOTAL, respectively, and by inserting in place thereof the amounts "18,600.00" and "\$62,680.00".
- 3.) The amendment to said agreement of August 20, 1979, set forth in Paragraph 1 shall be effective upon execution.
- 4.) Except as expressly amended hereby, said agreement of August 20, 1979, ratified by the parties and shall remain in full force and effect according to its terms.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, Level One, Inc., and City acting by and through its Mayor and Auditor and pursuant to Ordinance No. _____, have caused this agreement to be executed the day first hereinabove written.

ORDINANCE No. 149517

An Ordinance amending a contract authorized by Ordinance No. 148205, August 1, 1979, with Level One, Inc., to increase the amount for furnishing requested and preventative maintenance to the Bureau of Computer Services by \$6,800, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1.) Ordinance No. 149268, approved March 13, 1980, increased the amount to be expended for unexpected, emergency maintenance and updating for the Bureau of Emergency Communication's Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) system, of which \$2,500 is to provide for services from Level One, Inc.
- 2.) Ordinance No. 149422, approved April 10, 1980, provided funds for the Bureau of Emergency Communications for investigating the expansion of the Mobile Digital Terminal (MDT) system, for services from Level One, Inc., for modification and capacity analysis of the computer system, with additional funds being provided by the Bureau of Police and the Bureau of Electronic Services, for a total of \$4,300.
- 3.) An increase in the amount authorized for Contract No. 18115 between Level One, Inc., and the Bureau of Computer Services is necessary to effect these services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a.) Funds are transferred within the General Fund from Unforeseen Reimbursable Expenditures to the Bureau of Computer Services as follows:

- b.) That Contract No. 18115 with Level One, Inc., be amended to increase funds for routine and emergency maintenance of the CAD and MDT systems.
- c.) The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City a contract amendment as set forth in Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists, because delay will impact required computerized services; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
