

ORDINANCE NO. **149526**

An Ordinance authorizing acceptance of Grant No. 80-60 in the amount of \$8,028 from the Oregon State Office of Elderly Affairs for training as authorized under Title IV-A of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended under the Human Resources Bureau for the period from October 1, 1979, through September 30, 1980, amending the City Budget by increasing appropriations and transferring funds, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 147721, the City authorized the acceptance of the application for an Annual Plan of Action which includes social and nutrition services, and includes training activities for staff, advisory council and service providers under Title IV-A of the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended.
2. The City has received a notification of Grant Award No. 80-60 in the amount of \$8,028 to provide training for staff, advisory councils, and service providers during the period October 1, 1979, through September 30, 1980.
3. The City Budget already includes appropriations in the amount of \$7,871 for this purpose.
4. Appropriations need to be increased by \$157 to be in accordance with the received grant award.
5. Indirect costs are not allowed.
6. City match is not required.
7. It is, therefore, appropriate for the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor to accept, on behalf of the City of Portland, Grant No. 80-60 in the amount of \$8,028 for the period October 1, 1979 through September 30, 1980 for the implementation of training activities as part of the Annual Plan of Action for aging services in Portland/Multnomah County, as set forth in Exhibit "A", and to amend the fiscal year 1978-79 Budget by increasing appropriations and transferring funds.

ORDINANCE No.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are hereby authorized to accept, on behalf of the City of Portland, Grant No. 80-60 in the amount of \$8,028 for the period October 1, 1979, through September 30, 1980, for the implementation of training activities as part of the Annual Plan of Action for Aging Services in Portland/Multnomah County as set forth in Exhibit "A", and to amend the Fiscal Year 1978-79 budget by increasing appropriations and transferring funds.
- b. The City Budget is hereby amended as follows:
