

ORDINANCE No. 149532

An Ordinance authorizing the creation of five (5) positions with the Bureau of Parks and Recreation for the City of Portland for the period beginning May 1, 1980 and ending September 30, 1980; creating five (5) positions under the Youth Community Conservation and Improvement Projects under CETA Title IV; transferring appropriations within the CETA fund in the amount of \$52,102, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland has been designated by the United States Department of Labor as Prime Sponsor for administering funds under CETA Title IV to provide employment and training opportunities for unemployed youth.
2. The Bureau of Parks and Recreation for the City of Portland is requesting authorization to utilize five (5) Youth Community Conservation and Improvement Projects positions to augment the Operations Division and provide trail building and storm damage cleanup within existing City parks.
3. The Bureau of Parks and Recreation requires the positions to provide coordination and supervisory personnel for in-city youth identified by the Youth Career Training Unit of the Training and Employment Division, Human Resources Bureau as meeting the eligibility criteria for the Youth Community Conservation and Improvement Projects.
4. The positions requested have the approval of the Training and Employment Division's Youth Career Training Unit, the Training and Employment Division Manager, and the Executive Director of the Human Resources Bureau.
5. Funds are available within the CETA Fund in the Fiscal Year 1979-80 Budget to provide for the cost of the positions created herein.
6. The period from July 1, 1980 through September 30, 1980 is contingent upon FY 1980-81 Budget approval by the City Council.
7. The positions and the City Bureau to which they are assigned are set forth in Attachment "A" hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. That five (5) CETA Title IV positions be created in the Bureau of Parks and Recreation as set out in Attachment "A" hereof.


- b. The Finance Officer is hereby authorized to amend the 1979-80 City Budget with transfer of appropriations within the CETA fund as follows:
