Portland City Charter §3-301(a)–(b)(1) Portland City Code Ch. 2.10.010A.–B.1.

Summary:

The City Charter and City Code require the Auditor's Office to issue a complaint when provided a reason to believe that a violation of Campaign Finance Regulations may have occurred. See Portland City Charter 3-305(d) and Portland City Code Ch. 2.10.050 D.



On July 8, 2020, the Auditor's Office received information providing a basis for belief of potential violation(s) of Campaign Finance Regulations by Friends of Ted Wheeler. The Auditor's Office initiates this complaint to pursue further investigation.

Allegation(s):

The Auditor's Office alleges violation(s) of Campaign Finance Regulations, in that Friends of Ted Wheeler received one or more contributions from individuals that exceeded the \$500 limit per election cycle per individual contributor.

- 1. Ted Wheeler is the current mayor and the incumbent mayoral candidate for the November 3, 2020, General Election. Ted Wheeler is a Candidate as defined in Portland City Code Ch. 2.10.080 A.
- 2. Friends of Ted Wheeler is the principal campaign committee of Ted Wheeler, and is a Candidate Committee as defined in Portland City Code Ch. 2.10.080 B.
- 3. On July 8, 2020, the City of Portland Election's Office received an email from Friends of Ted Wheeler that included the following information:
 - a) Ted Wheeler and Friends conducted a self-assessment of its records, looking back to post-General Election November 2016.
 - b) After a review of its records, Friends of Ted Wheeler identified seven donations of concern that occurred after May 4, 2020.
 - c) Each of the seven donations identified was from individual contributors and in excess of \$500.
 - d) The total contribution amount received by Friends of Ted Wheeler for the seven identified donations was \$3,250.
 - e) After identifying the above donations of concern, Friends of Ted Wheeler refunded the funds in question to the respective donors.
- 4. Ted Wheeler and Friends violated campaign contribution limitations by receiving contributions from individuals during the same election cycle that were more than \$500 per individual.

Timeline for Response and Investigation:

Under Portland City Code Section 2.10.050 E. 3., <u>you have until 5:00 PM on August 21</u>, 2020, to submit a written response to this complaint along with any relevant, supplemental <u>materials</u>. Please submit any such materials electronically, using the above-referenced case name, to <u>elections@portlandoregon.gov</u>. At this time, the Auditor's Office can only guarantee receipt of materials if sent by email.

After the 10-business-day period for submitting the written response, our office will render a decision within another 10 business days.
