\*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation to pay \$60,000 to design and install City Standard signal equipment on the Outer Powell Transportation Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is designing and constructing street improvements on SE Powell Blvd from Interstate 205 to the city limits.
- 2. Upon completion of the project ODOT intends to transfer SE Powell Blvd to the City of Portland through a future Intergovernmental Agreement.
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) and ODOT have agreed to design and install traffic signal equipment that meets PBOT standards to reduce future maintenance burdens.
- 4. PBOT has agreed to compensate ODOT up to \$60,000 for additional design costs necessary to use PBOT standard signal equipment.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into an a. Intergovernmental Agreement with ODOT in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is necessary for design of the project to continue design, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
