Dear Mr. Bradfish:

I have been in contact with Joan Swinney of the City of Portland AIA concerning the architectural models for the International Design Conference in Aspen. As she working out the logistics for shipping and insuring the exhibit to Aspen, it became apparent that we were not budgeted to receive it.

Each architect required \$100,000 insurance for his respective model. The shipping charges alone would have been around \$4000 and packing about \$300. While we felt that the architectural models would have been an appropriate display for the conference on Form and Purpose, the cost was prohibitive.

Thank you so much for the assistance that you gave us in arranging for us to have the exhibit. We are disappointed that it did not work for us this year.

## ORDINANCE NO. 149558

An Ordinance authorizing a 45-day loan of the Public Service Building models to the International Design Conference in Aspen for display in Aspen, Colorado on June 15-20, 1980, establishing conditions, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland has received proposals for construction of a public office building, which proposals include models of the buildings.
2. The City has received a request from Moshe Safdie, Conference Chairman for the International Design Conference in Aspen (IDCA), to display the Public Service Building models at the meeting in Aspen, Colorado on June 15-20, 1980.
3. The Portland Chapter of the American Institute of Architects has offered to arrange for packing, shipping, insuring, and returning the models to the City.
4. It would be in the public interest to display the models at the design conference.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Utilities is authorized to loan those models of the Public Service Building, which are the property of the City of Portland, to the International Design Conference in Aspen, P. O. Box 664, Aspen, Colorado, 81611, Moshe Safdie Conference Chairman, for display at the International Design Conference on June 15-20, 1980. Such loan will be for a period not to exceed 45 days and under the following conditions:
  - (1) The models will be packed and shipped by a firm experienced in handling works of art.
  - (2) IDCA will obtain insurance to cover all costs if the models are lost or damaged.
  - (3) IDCA will pay all expenses for the packing, shipping, insuring, and return of the models to the City of Portland, Oregon.
- b. This Ordinance shall not take effect until the terms are accepted in writing by IDCA on forms provided by the City Auditor.

## ORDINANCE No.


Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay would preclude display of the models at the required time; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
